2. Carl Homer ARNDT-61 died 1953 in Colton, San Bernardino, Calif. and was buried 1953 in Fort Rosecrans, San Diego, Natl. Cemetary, Calif.. He married Amada T. LLAMAS-59 on 1929 in March Field, Riverside, Riverside, Calif. (MRIN:14). The marriage ended in divorce.

He served in the U.S.Army in WW-I and received the Purple Heart Medal for being wounded in action. He retired from the Army Air Corps after WW-II.

BURIAL: Buried in Fort Rosecrans National Cemetary, Point Loma, San Diego, CA.

3. Amada T. LLAMAS-59 was born 22 Jul 1906 in Riverside. was buried in National Cem., Riverside.

6. Jose Jesus Gervacio LLAMAS-18 was born 19 Jun 1872 in unknown, Sonora, Mexico and was christened 11 Jul 1872 in Alter de Alter, Sonora, Mexico. He died 2 Jan 1962 in Riverside, Riverside, Calif. and was buried Jan 1962 in Olivewood Cem., Riverside, Riverside, Calif.. Jose married Eva Lebra Levarda CASTILLO-38 on 21 Feb 1895 in Riverside, Riverside, California (MRIN:7).
7. Eva Lebra Levarda CASTILLO-38 was born 13 Jan 1875 in Aqua Mansa, Colton, San Bernardino, Calif.. She died 27 Dec 1959 in Riverside, Riverside, Calif. and was buried 30 Dec 1959 in Olivewood Cem., Riverside, Riverside, Calif..

12. Jesus LLAMAS-77 was born 5 Jan 1822 in Mexico. He died 17 Feb 1898 in Casa Blanca, Riverside, Riverside, Calif.. Jesus married Teofila PENA-618 (MRIN:20).

He was a traveling pedler, he sold dry goods all over the South West.

13. Teofila PENA-618 was born about 1852.

14. Jesus CASTILLO-14 was born 1845 in Mexico. He died 21 May 1924 in at home, Riverside, Riverside, Calif. and was buried 30 May 1924 in Evergreen Cem., Riverside, Riverside, Calif.. Jesus married Maria Lugarda SILVAS-15 in California (MRIN:5).

The 1880 U.S. census shows that the family lived in Chino, CA and he was a farm laborer. They had 9 children living at home with them. His obituary said that he was 98 years old when he died in Riverside, but the 1880 census shows that he would have been 84. He lived behind his daughter, Paz (Castillo) Loustaunau, in the little adobe house behind the big house at 4420 Brockton Ave. in Riverside, CA until his death.

15. Maria Lugarda SILVAS-15 was born 1844 in San Gabriel Miss, CA.

She was born at the Mission San Gabriel, Los Angeles County. Some of her ancestors died at that mission. She did have some Cahuilla Indian blood, but we don't know how much. However it was enough for her grandson Eddie Loustaunau to get a minority business loan and a scholarship for his daughter. Jay Silvas, Eddie's cousin helped Eddie prove his entitlement for this, but unfortunately the details of these transactions were lost with the passing of both Eddie & Jay. Her daughters, Paz (Castillo) Loustaunau & Eva (Castillo) Llamas were given some money for being part of the San Gabriel Mission Indians families, when a new road was put in front of the mission and the city took some mission land for it back in the 1930's, this was paid as a result of a law suit.

30. Jose Francisco SILVAS-940 was born 1813 in Presidio, San Diego, CA. He married Maria de los Reyes LOPEZ-941 (MRIN:359).
31. Maria de los Reyes LOPEZ-941 was born about 1814. She died after 1854.

60. Juan Segundo de Dukal Joseph SILVAS-956 was born 1787 in San Diego, CA and was christened 19 Jul 1787 in San Diego, CA. He died after 1834. Juan married Maria Quitera ALVEREZ-957 (MRIN:363).
61. Maria Quitera ALVEREZ-957 was born 1796 in San Diego, CA. She died after 1834.
62. Juan LOPEZ-950 was born about 1784 in Loreto, Baja California. He married Maria Josefa Nicolasa VERDUGO-951 (MRIN:360).
63. Maria Josefa Nicolasa VERDUGO-951 was born 1792 in Mission, San Gabriel, CA. She died 1863 in San Diego, CA.

120. Jose Manuel SILVAS-970 was born about 1765 in Villa Sinaloa, Mexico. He died after 1841. Jose married Maria Gertrudis CAMACHO-971 on 11 Jun 1786 in Rosario de Arrib, Baja, California (MRIN:365).

Jose Manuel is listed as a 10 year old servant in the 1776 Anza party according to Bancroft.

121. Maria Gertrudis CAMACHO-971 was born 1768 in Santa Gertrudis, Baja California. She died before 1837 in San Juan Capistr, CA.

The San Diego Presidio census of 1790, says that she was a 22 year old, mulata, from Santa Gertrudis, Baja ,CA, married to Manuel Silvas an espanol from Villa Sinaloa, Mexico, age 27 with two children: Juan Jose, 3 years and Jose Maria 2 years old.

122. Juan Pedro ALVAREZ-968 was born about 1760 in Pueblo de Potan, Sonora. He died 6 Feb 1828 in San Gabriel Miss, Los Angeles, CA. Juan married Maria Teresa Marquez GRACIANO-969 (MRIN:364).

The Jan.1, 1780 garrison list for the San Diego Presidio, listed him as a Private in the Army. The garrison list for May 20, 1782 listed him as a soldier (age 29), his Caste was Mestizo (from Rio Yaqui, Sonora, Mexico and was married. The garrison list for December 1, 1784, lists him as a soldier. The 1790 census lists him color quebrado (people with some degree of African ancestry)from the Yaqui River, Sonora, Mexico. Married to Maria Teresa Graciana Marquez,a mulata, age 28, four children: Doroteo, 10; Maria Bernarda, 12; Josefa Alvina, 7; and Maria Luisa, 2.

BIRTH: Bancroft says that he was born in Pueblo de Potan, Rio Yaqui, Sonora, Mexico

123. Maria Teresa Marquez GRACIANO-969 was born about 1762 in San Ygnacio, Baja California. She died 1808 and was buried 22 Dec 1808 in San Gabriel Miss, Los Angeles, CA.

124. Juan Bautista LOPEZ-954 was born about 1754 in Mission Santiago, Baja California. was buried 6 Dec 1781. Juan married Maria Dolores SALGADO-955 about 1782 in Mission Loreto, Baja CA, Mexico (MRIN:362).

According to "Antepasados", the publication of Los Californios, Volume IV, 1980-1981, The Los Angeles 1822 census says: Antonio Lopez y su mur., Dolores Salgado, ambos color triguenos. Early California Family notes says that he was a 1798 settler of Los Angeles.

125. Maria Dolores SALGADO-955 was born 1768 in Royal Presidio, Loreto, Baja, CA. was buried 17 Jan 1854 in La Playa Church, Los Angeles, CA.

According to "Antepasados", the journal of Los Californios, in the LA 1822 census the following appears: Juan Lopez y su muj., Dolores Salgado, ambos color triguenos.

126. Juan Maria VERDUGO-952 was born 1762 in Loreto, Baja California. He married Maria Matilda AMESQUITA-953 on 4 Nov 1783 (MRIN:361).

The 1790 census shows that he was a Private in the army at the Presidio in San Diego. He was 28 years old, was an espanol and was married to Matilde Amezquita, a 21 year old mulata, from Terrenante, Sonora, Mexico. A garrison list dated December 31,1794 lists him as one of the soldiers at the Presidio in San Diego.

127. Maria Matilda AMESQUITA-953 was born 1769 in Tubac, Sonora, Mexico. She died 1812 in San Diego, CA.

She is listed in the report of the families of troops recruited in the provinces of the government of Sonora by Captain De Anza in 1775 and she was on De Anza'a 2nd expedition

and was married to Juan Verdugo an espanol (aged 28) from Loreto, Baja California.

240. Jose Miguel SILVAS-986 was born about 1734 in Villa de Sinaloa, Mexico. He died 7 Dec 1789 in Presidio, San Diego, CA. Jose married Maria Pascuala LUGO-987 on 1772 in Villa de Sinaloa, Sinaloa Mexico (MRIN:368).

The book by Marie E. Northrop called Spanish-American Families of Early California: 1769-1850, Volume II, 1984, page 266 says that Jose Miguel Silvas: Came with De Anza in 1776 Expedition; *soldado de cuera(leatherjacket soldier)at San Francisco in 1776; in San Francisco 1782; at San Diego in 1783. page 14 says that his daughter (Maria Bernarda Silvas) came with her parents in the 1776 Anza Expedition and settled at Pueblo de Los Angeles in 1789. Bancroft lists him as being in California before 1800.

*** Leather jacket soldiers(soldados de cuera)wore a highly distinctive jacket made from seven layers of buckskin worn for protection against indian arrows & javelins.**

241. Maria Pascuala LUGO-987 was born about 1750 in Sinaloa, Mexico. She died 1824 in Los Angeles, CA and was buried 2 Feb 1824 in San Gabriel Miss, CA.

Maria Pascuala Lugo and her children: Maria Josefa Gabirela Silvas, Maria Valbanera Silvas, Maria Bernarda Silvas, Ana Gertrudis Silvas, and Teodoro Silvas are listed as being members of the 1781 Rivera and Mondada Expedition. Her husband, Jose Miguel Silvas, a soldero de Cuera, was already in California. He and their son, Jose Manuel Silvas, who was listed as a servant, age 10, arrived with the 1776 Anza party. This is from the Los Californios publication "Antepasados" dated 1980-1981 Volume IV.

242. Juan Miguel CAMACHO-972 was born about 1742. He died before 1803. Juan married Maria Josefa COTA-973 (MRIN:366).

243. Maria Josefa COTA-973 was born about 1750 in Loreta, Baja California.

246. Antonio GRACIANO-1000 was born about 1736 in San Ygnacio, Baja, CA. He married Maria Ysidora MARQUEZ-1001 (MRIN:371).

247. Maria Ysidora MARQUEZ-1001 was born about 1740 in Baja, CA.

248. Jose Ygnacio De Juan LOPEZ-1002 was born about 1728 in Loreto, Baja, CA, Mexico. was buried 6 Dec 1781 in Mission San Juan, Capistrano, CA. Jose married Maria Fecunda MORA-1003 about 1744 in Baja, CA, Mexico (MRIN:372).

249. Maria Fecunda MORA-1003 was born about 1725 in Santiago de Los, Baja CA, Mexico. She died before 1799 in Baja CA, Mexico.

252. Juan Diego VERDUGO-1038 was born about 1715 in El Fuerte, Sinaloa, Mexico. He died 23 Jan 1780 in San Gabriel, Mission. Juan married Maria Ygnacia de la Concepcion CARRILLO-1039 (MRIN:380).

Juan Diego was a soldier at San Diego Presidio in 1776. This is from Spanish Families of Southern California, Dr. Adam C. Derkim's notebooks.

253. Maria Ygnacia de la Concepcion CARRILLO-1039 was born about 1725 in Royal Presidio, Loreto, B.C.. She died 24 Apr 1798 in San Gabriel, Mission.

254. Juan Antonio AMESQUITA-1057 was born 1740. He married Juana GAONA-1058 (MRIN:384).

Birth information was obtained from "Antepasados" a publication of the Los Californianos, Volume VIII, 1995. In a letter dated 1-10-1775 to De Anza from Bucareli y Ursua(Viceroy of New Spain) says that Juan Antonio Amesquita was a soldier at the Presidio Tubac and that he was one of seven soldiers selected to accompany De Anza on his 2nd Expedition and to move

482. Juan Salvador LUGO-994 was born 1714 in Villa Sinaloa, Mexico. He married Maria Josefa Francisca ESPINOSA-995 about 1739 in Villa de Sinaloa, Mexico (MRIN:369).
483. Maria Josefa Francisca ESPINOSA-995 was born 1716.
486. Andres de COTA-974 was born about 1700 in El Fuerte, Sinaloa, Mexico. He died after 1790 in Baja California. Andres de married Angela de LEON-975 on 1722 in El Fuerte, Sinaloa, Baja California (MRIN:367).

DEATH: Dr. Adam Dirkin's Notebooks (Spanish Families of Southern California LDS microfilm roll #1597975 says that Andres was a soldier in Los Angeles in 1769.

487. Angela de LEON-975 was born about 1705 in El Fuerte, Sinaloa, Mexico. She died in Baja California.
496. Andres LOPEZ-1004 was born before 1713 in Mexico. He married Rosa SOTO-1005 before 1728 in Loreto, Baja CA, Mexico (MRIN:373).
497. Rosa SOTO-1005 was born before 1715 in Mexico.
506. Juan CARRILLO-1041 was born about 1690. He died about May 1748 in Loreta, Baja California. Juan married Lucia Efejmia MILLER (MIJAR)-1040 (MRIN:381).
507. Lucia Efejmia MILLER (MIJAR)-1040 was born about 1700.
