THE BRUNSON FAMILY IN SOUTH CAROLINA

This family originates in South Carolina with Abraham and Isaac Brunson who received land grants in Berkeley County on the Ashley River in 1705. Margaret Brownson, widow of Isaac Brownson, the son of John Brownson, Sr., deceased, in 1739, conveyed her rights to land in Farmington and Wethersfield, Connecticut to her five sons: George, Isaac, James, William, and David--all of Craven County, S. C. It is interesting to note the various spellings of the name. A record in 1674 indicates three brothers using the following variants: Bronson, Brownson, and Brunson.

The family had originally emigrated from England to Massachusetts about 1633, probably with the Rev. Thomas Hooker's Congregation (Puritan) and moved to Hartford, Connecticut. The emigrants were Richard and his two sons, Richard, Jr. (c.1617-1687) and John (c.1619-1680). Richard, Jr.'s son, John (1645-1712) was the progenitor of the South Carolina families of Brunsons and came with his two sons, Abraham and Isaac, to South Carolina. The first settlement by this family in S. C. seems to have been in Dorchester. Later generations located on the Santee, Wateree, and Black Rivers in the Sumter-Clarendon area, earlier identified as that part of Prince Frederick's Parish which became St. Mark's Parish. Others are found in Berkeley County on the Edisto River, in Edgefield, in Cheraw, and in Camden. Several branches migrated to Georgia, Alabama, and Florida.

In addition to the Revolutionary Soldiers marked with an asterisk on the chart, Charles Brunson, George Brunson, and William Brunson signed along with Matthew Brunson in 1775 to form a Volunteer Company. These have not been identified. Matthew Brunson was killed in action in Clarendon County.

Admittedly, this chart is incomplete, but it does represent the facts that we have been able to establish from the records available to us. We would welcome any additions or corrections from our readers.
