I Abraham Buford of Georgetown in the County  
of Scott in the State of Kentucky do hereby de-  
clare that I was an officer in the Continental  
line of the Army of the revolution and served  
and continued as such to the end of the war  
At which period I was a Colonel in the  
Regiment of the Virginia line

And I also declare that I afterwards recei-  
ved a Certificate (commonly called a commuta-  
tion Certificate for a sum equal to the amount  
of five years full pay which sum was ordered by  
the resolves of Congress of the 22<sup>d</sup> of March 1783  
instead of the half pay for life to which I was  
intitled under the resolves of the 21<sup>st</sup> of October  
1780. And I do further declare that I have  
received of the United States as a pensioner  
since the 3<sup>d</sup> day of March 1826 no money or  
that I have received as a pensioner of the  
United States since the 3<sup>d</sup> day of March 1828  
no money nor money paid to me by the agent  
for paying pensions in the State of Kentucky

The loss of my Regiment is not stated owing  
to my having been ordered by Gen<sup>l</sup> Washington  
in the spring of the year 1799. To form and

take command of a Regiment or detachment  
of new levies or drafts in the State of Virginia  
and march to the South Carolina under the Com

mand of General Charles Scott, after which I did  
not return to the Northern army where I

my 10<sup>th</sup> Virginia Regiment in the spring.

I therefore know not what re-creation or arrange-  
ment of Regiments was made after I left there.

REVOLUTIONARY CLAIMS.

TREASURY DEPARTMENT,

Aug. 30. 1828

*Abraham Buford*, of *Georgetown*, in the County of *Scott*, in the State of *Kentucky*, has applied to the Secretary of the Treasury for the benefits of the act, entitled "An Act for the relief of certain surviving officers and soldiers of the army of the Revolution," approved on the 15th of May, 1828. He states that he was as an officer on the Continental line, and served as such *to the end of the war,*

at which period he was, a *Colonel* in the *—* regiment of the *Virginia* line; and that he received commutation certificates for the five years full pay granted by the resolve of 23 March, 1783; and, further, that he has received as a pensioner since the 3d of March, 1826, *nothing* dollars, paid to him by the agent in the State of *—*

The Third Auditor is requested to report how far these several statements are corroborated by the records in his office.

It appears by the records in this office, that final settlement certificates have been issued for the commutation of five years full pay to *Abraham Buford*, *Colonel* in the *Virginia* line, amounting to *Forty five thousand* dollars. It further appears that *Abraham Buford* is now on the pension list of *any* agency, and has been since the *3. March* 1826 *per month*

Dear Madam:

Reference is made to your letter in which you request information in regard to Abram Buford, who served as major, lieutenant-colonel, and colonel in the Revolutionary War.

The data which follow are found in the papers on file in pension claim, S. 46372, based upon service of Abraham Buford, the officer cited by you.

Abraham Buford served as an officer in the Virginia line during the Revolutionary War, was with the Northern Army, in the spring of 1779, commanded a Virginia regiment, marched to South Carolina under General Charles Scott, and continued in service until the close of the war in 1783; at which time he was a colonel in the Virginia line. The residence of this officer at enlistment, the dates of his commissions, and the length of his service are not shown in this claim.

Abraham Buford applied August 30, 1828 for the pension which was due on account of his service as an officer in the Revolutionary War. At that time, he resided in Georgetown, Scott County, Kentucky. His name was placed on the pension roll September 8, 1828, pension to commence March 3, 1828. He was allowed 500 acres of bounty land on warrant #251, issued May 3, 1793 on account of his service as colonel in the Revolutionary War.

This officer made no reference to wife or children at the time he made application for his pension.

The Report of the Secretary of War in regard to the Pension Establishment of the United States, printed in 1835, shows that Abraham Buford, the pensioner of Scott County, Kentucky, died June 29,

1833, and that his representative or agent was his widow, Martha.

It is suggested that further information in regard to the military record of Abraham Buford might be obtained from The Adjutant General, War Department, this city.

If you desire information in regard to the location of the land which was granted on account of service of Colonel Abraham Buford by the United States, you should address the Commissioner, General Land Office, this city, and furnish that official the following: warrant #351 for 800 acres of bounty land, issued May 3, 1793.

In order to obtain the date of the last payment of pension, the name and address of person paid, you should address The Comptroller General, General Accounting Office, this city, and furnish the following-
