"E. N. Clark, P. O. Postville, farmer, sec. 21; owns 420 acres of land, valued at \$40 per acre; son of M. D. and Delilah Clark; was born in Wayne Co., N. Y., in 1838, his parents emigrating to Saginaw, Mich., in 1841, engaging in the lumbering business till in 1848, when they moved to Linn Co., Io. [sic]. At the breaking out of the rebellion, in June, 1861, he enlisted in Co. A, 6th Ia. Inf., serving until the close of the war. He participated in the battles at Pittsburg Landing, Black River and the capture of Vicksburg; returned home in 1865, soon after moving to Delaware Co., Io. [sic], having secured a government contract for a mail and state [sic] route between Postville and Dyersville, which he run [sic] four years, after which he moved to this county. Mr. C. was first married to Miss Martha Reed, in 1860, by whom he had four children: Mary D., Elmer C., Ulysses G. and Minnie C. His wife died in 1869 and he was again married to Mrs. Lucy Clark, widow of J. W. Clark and daughter of Calvin Dresser, in 1871. His wife has three children by her first marriage: Franklin, Charles and Calvin D. Mr. C. is a member of the A. O. U. W."

"John T. Clark, Attorney, Postville, is a native of Madison Co., N. Y., being born in 1811; received his early education in the common schools; followed agricultural pursuits till in 1843, commenced reading law under the preceptorship of Timothy Jenkins, of Oneida Co., N.Y., and subsequently with Thos. Flandreau of the fall of 1853 he emigrated to Iowa, locating in Waukon, there being but two frame dwellings, he building the third. He remained there following his profession until Dec., 1859, when he removed to Decorah and established a law office in company with his son, Orlando J. Clark. While there he was extensively interested in real estate at Fort Atkinson, owning 160 acres of land upon which most of the town was platted. In 1874 he returned to Waukon where he remained till in June, 1880, he came to Postville and opened a law office. Mr. Clark was married to Miss Elizabeth Blakeslee, of N. Y., in 1833. His children are Orlando J., now a practicing attorney of Decorah, Frederick M., Charles B., Sarah E., Emma, Adelbert J., Alvin and Florence. All his sons served their country during the war of the rebellion. Mr. Clark served as one of the delegates in the Constitutional convention of 1857 at Iowa City, also as Prosecuting Attorney for Allamakee Co. for several years."

NOTE from contributor Glenn Clark Taylor: John T. Clark died 17 January 1885 at Postville, Allamakee County, Iowa, and is buried in the Postville Cemetery. He was my great-great-grandfather. I have been unable to find any information on his parents or birthplace. With seven children, there must be descendants out there. I know about Orlando J. Clark, my great-grandfather. Help on any of the others would be greatly appreciated. +++++

COLONEL JOSEPH CLARKE OF TENNESSEE (Continued from August)

Joseph T. Clarke, son of Col. Joseph Clarke's first marriage (mother unknown), was born 11 Nov 1807 either in Tennessee or Virginia. He died 19 Nov 1900 and was buried in Salem Baptist church Cemetery, in Liberty, DeKalb County, Tennessee.

It is believed that Joseph T. married three times. The first wife is unknown, but two children were born of that marriage:

- (1) Robert Lafayette, b. May 1831; m. 28 Jan 1852, in Liberty, TN, to Nancy H. Bratten, b. Apr 1832. Nancy was the dau/of Sarah (maiden name unknown) Bratton (b. 1804, MD), who lived w/ Robert and Nancy in DeKalb Co., TN, 1900. Robert Lafayette and Nancy H. Clarke had children--James, b. 1853; Mary J., b. 20 Mar 1856, d. 20 Jun 1885 (m. D. T. Ballinger); Sarah E., b. 9 Aug 1859, d. 7 Aug 1861; and Joseph L., b. 21 May 1865, d. 27 Aug 1866.
- (2) Celicia P. (Polly), b. 6 Apr 1830, Liberty, DeKalb Co., TN; d. 27 Sep 1869, Liberty, DeKalb Co., TN; bur. Salem Baptist Church, Liberty, TN; m. 22 Jan 1852 to William D. "Bill" Evans (b. 16 Aug 1829, d. 31 Mar 1889). William and Celicia Evans had children--Joseph C., b. 24 Mar 1853; Robert C. S., b. 15 Jul 1855; Mary E., b. 10 Nov 1858; Joe (or James), b ca 1861; William b. ca 1861; and Sarah J., who d. about 9 Jul 1896. Williams D. Evans' was the son of Joseph and Sarah (Griffin) Evans.

Joseph T. Clarke married second Nancy (Allen) Preston, born 1812 and buried in Salem Baptist Church Cemetery, Liberty, TN. (Nancy had two children by her first marriage: William Bethel Preston, b. 26 Aug 1830, and Emiline Preston, b. 1832.) Joseph's second marriage also produced two children: (1) Mary Elizabeth "Pop," b. 26 Jan 1839, Liberty, TN (who m. Joshua L. Hollandsworth, son of James and Elizabeth Hollandsworth), and (2) James A., b. 28 Sep 1847, who was killed at age 14 by Pomp Kersey and his men after a raid on a party on 24 Jul 1861.

Joseph T. Clarke married third Martha (Jones) Whaley on 7 Aug 1874. Martha (dau/of Frederick and Marie P. (Squires) Jones, was born 2 Jan 1834 and died 26 Sep 1888 in Liberty, TN, with burial in Salem Baptist Church Cemetery. Martha had three children by her first marriage: Elizabeth, Sarah F., and William L. Whaley. Joseph and Martha Clarke had only one child: Edgar Young Clarke, b. 30 Apr 1876, Liberty, DeKalb Co., TN; d. 22 Jun 1940; Lebanon, Wilson Co., TN; m. 1st Nannie Belle Borum, dau/of Isaac H. and Mary Anna (Patterson) Borum. Edgar and Nannie had four daughters, one of whom was Charley Clarke Grigg's (our contributor's) mother, Anna Mary, b. 29 Aug 1899, Liberty, TN, and died 13 Dec 1978, Nashville, TN, who m. Kenneth Nairon Grigg on 3 Mar 1917.
