DEATH CLAIMS MRS. M. SHOCK

The death of Mrs. Mate Shock, resident of St. Joseph for 18 years, came at 4 o'clock this morning at the Taber sanitarium, Benton Harbor. She was 54 years old.

Mrs. Shock was born in Ligonier, Ind. on Feb 10, 1873 and for a number of years resided at Lake Geneva, Wis.

She is the mother of two daughters, Mrs. Vervaine Tutton, wife of Harry V. Tutton whose home is in Edgewater and Mrs. Leah Frakes, of Benton Harbor. She also leaves one sister, Mrs. Belle Hadley of Daytona Beach, Fla.

In ill health for a year or more, Mrs. Shock had been a patient at the Tabor sanitarium for six weeks, and death was the result of a general breakdown. Through her illness she remained cheerful and optimistic and had become a favorite patient with nurses at the sanitarium. Friends today were shocked to learn of her death.

Funerál services will be conducted at the Dormer and Kerlikoske Funeral Home Monday afternoon at 2. The Rev. W. S. Dunlop rector of St. Pauls Episcopal church will officiate and burial will be in Riverview cemetery.

FRANK SHOCK SUCCEUMBS TO SEVEN YEAR ILLNESS

After a seven years illness with sugar diabetes, Frank R. Shock dies this morning at 10 o'clock at his home, 1102 Niles Avenue. Mr. Shock has been gradually failing for some time and a decided change for the worse was noticed during the past week. Yesterday he was about the house as usual, but early this morning it was noticed that he was sinking rapidly, his death following within a few hours.

Mr. Shock came to St. Joseph with his wife and two daughters five years ago in the hope that a change of climate might benefit him, but the disease had already become too deeply seated and it was impossible for his physicians to give him any permanent relief. Mrs. Shock was born in Lima, O., August 26, 1871. In 1894 he was married to Miss Mate Collins, who with her two daughters, Vervain and Leah, survive him. For 14 years he was in the liquor business and during that time the family resided in Chicago, Lake Geneva, Wis., and finally this city.

Beside his wife and children Mr. Shock is survived by his mother, Mrs. Amanda Shock, of Chicago, two brothers, Louis Shock of East Troy, Wis., and John of Chicago, and six sisters, Mrs. Carl King of Elkhart, formerly of this city, Mrs. Harry Newman ~~of~~ of Lake Geneva, Wis., Mrs. John Rathwiler North Branch, Minn., Mrs. Fred Smily, Mrs. John Kent and Miss Druzella Shock of Chicago.

The funeral arrangements have not been made pending arrival of relatives.

~~ix~~ Last Monday morning, after several years of suffering from that dread disease cancer, Mrs. Hannah Collins, well known to all of our people, quietly breathed her last. Mrs. Collins was born in Guelph, Ontario, Canada, February 25, 1836. She was married in 1858 to Michael Collins and in 1865 took up her residence in this city in company with her husband, who had accepted a bench in Sisterhen's shoe shop. In 1878 Mr Collins died, leaving his wife with four little children and an adopted daughter. She struggled valiently to sustain her family and always found a way to keep the wolf from the door. She conducted a millinery store here for many years and counted many of our best people among her friends and customers. But two of her children survive her, Mrs. M. M. Hadley and Mrs. F. R. Shock. her daughter ~~Sadie~~ Sadie and son James having died several years ago. The funeral yesterday at the Catholic church as largely attended. Rev. Father Yenn preached an excellent sermon, paying a just tribute to the many good qualities of the deceased.

1878 COLLINS - November 7, of inflammation of the bowels, Michael Collins age 47.

Deceased was born in the County of Arnaut, Ireland; migrated to Canada age 7, learned the shoemaker's trade, and remained there until 1865, when he removed to Ligonier, working a few months for Peter Sisterhen. Subsequently he became foreman of the shoe shops, respectively, of J. E. Congdon and Canfield & Emery. In 1871 he obtained a situation in the estanlishement of F. W. Shinke, in whose employ he remained up to time of his demise - a faithful, industrious and pains-taking workman.

Departed leaves a bereaved wife, four children & an adopted daughter to mourn their irreparable loss. The funeral took place on Sunday, the unusually large attendance attesting the esteem in which he as held by the community in general. An impressive and singularly forcible sermon was preached by Rev. Father Broeckman in the densely crowded Catholic church.
