## F.L. Holcombe Of Cumberland County Passes

FAYETTEVILLE, June 14 — Frank Lanman Holcombe, prominent Cumberland County dairy man, died last night at 8:10 o'clock in a local hospital after a two-day illness.

Funeral services will be held Sunday at 5 p.m. from the First Presbyterian Church by Dr. Walker B. Healy. Burial will be in Cross Creek cemetery.

Widely known as a state dairy expert, Mr. Holcombe was operating the Cottonade farm off Bragg Blvd. at the time of his death. He was born September 29, 1885, in Hartford, Conn., son of the late Amherst Lanman Holcombe and

Clara Frances Babbitt Holcombe. He was married to the former Inez Hallowell of Dow City, Iowa, in 1914. He was past president of the North Carolina Holstein-Friesian association, director of the North Carolina Milk Producers association and director of the North Carolina Dairy foundation.

Surviving in addition to his wife are two sons, Lt. Col. James H. Holcombe, serving overseas with the Army, Harold Holcombe of Asheboro; a daughter, Mrs. Tom Struthers of Sanford; one sister, Mrs. J. Talbot Johnson Aberdeen and five grandly designed. i and five grandchildren
