

This Indenture made by 31<sup>st</sup> Day of Janey 1684/5 between Nicholas Witterington only one part, and In<sup>o</sup> Mayor on<sup>e</sup> Behalfe of his Sonn  
In<sup>o</sup> Mayor, as also the said In<sup>o</sup> Mayor sonn on<sup>e</sup> other part witnesseth  
that<sup>e</sup> said In<sup>o</sup> Mayor son Confessing the good of his Sonn, doth  
agree that the<sup>t</sup> In<sup>o</sup> Mayor son shall servis<sup>e</sup> said Nech.  
Witterington will be come by age of one & twenty years.  
Receiving of me 1400 d<sup>r</sup> next Ymas) he said In<sup>o</sup> Mayor  
Jnn<sup>o</sup> being Confessing to the same, In Confederation w<sup>t</sup>  
Servitude of said Nech. Witterington doth oblige himself  
to teach the said In<sup>o</sup> Nech of Blacksmithing to go and  
fin<sup>e</sup> the learning of writing, Reading, penning, and  
frieses of rule, Pen, necessary Meale, drink, washing, Lodging  
and all expences of the said term, to pay deliver him  
two Cows with Calves, or Calves by their Sides, and Ma~~ny~~ 100  
and three Barrells offorne, for the sum of money of the  
pounds. The p<sup>t</sup> have been unto sett them hands the day  
of the above Espre<sup>d</sup>
