

John Milam or Melam was allowed pension on his application executed October 29, 1832, at which time he resided in Madison County, Alabama. His name was borne John Melam on the pension rolls. He died October 19 or 26, 1838, in Madison County, Alabama.

The soldier married in the year 1813, in Laurens District, South Carolina, Polly Allison.

Polly, the soldier's widow, was allowed pension on her application executed April 20, 1853, at which time she resided in Monroe County, Mississippi. She was then aged seventy-five years; the date and place of her birth and names of her parents are not shown.

No reference was made to children of the above noted soldier.

In order to obtain the date of last payment, name of person paid, and, possibly, the date of death of Polly Melam, you should apply to The Comptroller General, General Accounting Office, Records Division, this city, and cite the following:
