

At a very early period in the settlement of the State of S.C. came over from England Thomas and Mary his wife; they settled at the old plantation Poplar Spring in St. Pauls Parish. They had six children but we will trace two sons on this page: John and Wm.

John married Miss Ledson and from them are descended the Jeremiah Miles, the Lees and Dickinsons. Wm married Miss McKewn, they had two sons: James your forefather and Robert my forefather. James married Miss Joanna Garner, they had a son named James who married twice: his 1st wife was Miss Rachel Porcher; they had 3 children: a son James, a dau Mary Porcher who died when a baby, and a dau. Eliz; the 2nd wife was Miss Eliza S. Miles; she never had a child. James the son of the 1st marriage married Miss Warley, the dau. Eliz. married Mr. John Gilbert; the generations are thus:

Now we will take my forefather Robert, son of Wm + Miss McKewn.

Robert married Miss Eliz. Smith dau. of Rigdon Smith of No. Car.; they had 5 ch. to grow up: Ann Mashaw ("Aunt Garner")
Eliza Smith ("Grandma") (later m. James, no children)

Wm never married ("Uncle Billy")
John Miles (my grandfather)

John married twice: first wife Miss Susan Braly; they had 5 ch. named:

- Robert (the Dr.)
- Thomas Braly (my father)
- William (never married)
- Mary (never married)
- Smith m. Miss Ryan

The 2nd wife of John was the widow Gardner; they had 7 children as follows:

So you see we had the same forefathers down to Wm + Miss McDewen.

1st generation ^{error - REHP} Thomas + Mary his wife came from Eng.; 2nd generation their son John married Miss ^{Elizabeth} Hadson; 3rd generation John intermarried with the widow Perry who had been Miss ^{Keriah} McPherson. 4th generation Jeremiah married Miss Keriah the eldest dau. of Mr. Wm + Mrs. Eliz. ^{Day} ~~Day~~; 5th generation John died single. Jeremiah was united to Miss Sarah ^{Farr} ~~Farr~~ the only dau. of Mr. ^{George} ~~George~~ and Jane ^{Ladson} ~~Ladson~~ Waring; he died leaving his 2 sons John Allen + Jeremiah. Their mother then married Col. Benjamin Perry of St. Pauls Parish. Keriah only dau. of the 5th generation married Mr. ^{Jones} Thomas Pickens of Pickens Dist S.C. was the mother of a large family some of whom are Col. Samuel Pickens of Chas., Mr. Patrick Pickens, + Dr Pickens in the upper part of the State. The daus. are: ^{6th generation} Mrs. Jeremiah Miles of Summerville, Mrs. Waring of Chas. + Mrs. Dr. — of Barnwell; the eldest dau. Eliza is single.

6th generation: John Allen Miles was killed in the War; fell in Virginia; he married Eliza Hadson Webb, dau. of Mr. Thomas Webb of Chas.; left one child, Dr. John Allen Miles, dentist of Chas. who lately married Miss Fannie Butler of Columbia.

6th gen. Jeremiah married his 1st cousin Anna Pickens; they have 3 sons named John Allen, Jeremiah + Samuel Pickens; these are all at present time small children.

(16) Miss Keriah, sister of the 1st Jeremiah Miles, was the wife of the Hon. Judge Thomas Lee; their children formed the 5th generation ~~are~~ as follows:

Dr. William Lee m. Miss Baker; Stephen ^{Lee} m. his cousin Caroline Lee (dau. of his uncle Mr. Wm. Lee and his wife Miss Mackley; they had a family of 12 children. Thomas ^{Lee} (another son) Joseph ^{Lee} (another son whose wife was Mary Singleton, dau. of Mr. Benjamin Singleton.)

Miss Elizabeth Lee died in 1853

Isaac McPherson ^{Lee} married a cousin in Alabama, the dau. of Major Paul S.H. Lee and after her death to one of Mr. Francis Lee's daughters; he had 2 sons by his 1st wife Maria, and 2 dau. named Jane + ~~Keriah~~ Keriah — and several children by the 2nd wife, names not told.

Dr. Lawrence Lee married his 1st cousin Miss Sarah Dickinson. The 6th generation includes the many children of the above.

Dr. William Lee's son John Lee ⁺¹⁸⁶⁵ married Miss Elizabeth Miles and the daughter of

Mr. John Miles & his 2nd wife the widow Garden, originally Miss Brailsford; (3) she died leaving 2 young daughters Annie (m. twice 2 brothers named McSween) Henrietta married Mr. Tyrrell.

(2nd page) We return to the 4th generation where we find Miss Rachel Miles become Mrs. Francis Dickinson; their son Jeremiah Dickinson 1st married his 1st cousin Caroline Lee, dau. of Mr. Stephen Shrewsbury and his wife Miss Dickinson; 2nd wife of Jeremiah Dickinson was Miss Logan; the 2nd wife died in Mobile in 1852 leaving their oldest son in Mobile and 5 younger children to their grandmother who brought them back to S.C.; they are; Susan (+ single), Sarah (m. Dr. L. Lee), Rachel (m. — Green)

We go back to the "3rd set"; there we find Josiah + ^{Allen} John dying without issue. Of the same we have ~~Miss~~ Mary (Mrs. Edw. Perry); then in the 4th generation their son married Miss Drayton; in the 5th their son Edw. Drayton Perry who was 1st married to Miss Carroll and after her death to Maria Headley, the widow of Mr. Manger; after Edw. D. Perry's death she again marries a Mr. Fuller of Beaufort.

In the 6th gen. the ch. of Edw. Perry + 1st wife (Miss Carroll) were: Ann, Edw., Charles + Mary; by 2nd wife Mrs. Manger one dau. Anna Perry who became Mrs. Thomas R. Waring of Chas.; their children were: Hayne Waring (m. Miss Dawson) Edward m. Anna — of Columbia.

(3rd page) We go back to the 2nd generation Silas (son of immigrants Thomas + Mary) left a dau. named Martha; she became Mrs. Griffith + afterwards Mrs. McNeil. [Another dau. was Mrs. Huxam.]

[Thomas] 2nd generation son of the ^{Thos.} Emigrants married Miss McPherson, his dau. married her cousin General McPherson, another dau. Rachel was Mrs. Cater and still another dau. Mrs. Nathaniel Farr ^{Mrs. Thomas Hadson} Elizabeth dau. of the ^{Thos. Hadson} emigrants was Mrs. Isaac McPherson, ~~her son was~~ James E. McPherson ^{Thos. Hadson}

In the 3rd generation after the death of James Miles with Miss Joanna Garner their son was James in the 4th generation who was your great grandfather. Joanna married Robert Reid from whom came Robert Raymond Reid of the 4th generation; he married a Miss McChaw. Another child of Joanna + Robert Reid ^{b. 8 Sep. 1789.} was Sarah Hanson married William Black. In the 5th generation Robert Raymond Reid's children are: James + Robert, daughters Joanna m. to Mr. Black and Flora to Mr. Dancy.

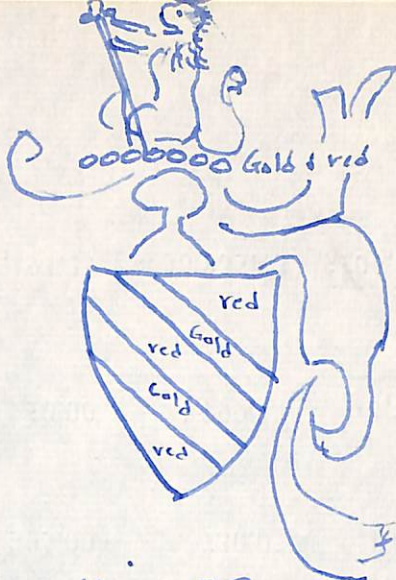
