JOHN MILES received Warrant 31 Dec. 1694 for 140 A. for arrival of self and Arnold Horgkinns.
received Warrant for 160 A. purchased from Proprietors 8 Apr. 1696.
received Warrant for 500 A. 7 Apr. 1704 (S.C. Land Grants)

Will of Joseph Edwards, recorded 14 Mar. 1693/4 names ANTHONY MILES, (deceased 30 Oct. 1693) and his son, WILLIAM MILES (under 21 yrs. as of 30 Oct. 1693; Walter HOOKLEY his Guardian and "Father-in-law".

23 Jan 1718/9 Wm. Miles & Thomas Miles Executors along with Martha, wife of Richard Vincent. John Miles, Sr. and Miles Rivers witnesses.

24 Feb. 1720/1 John Miles wit. to will of John Girardeau

14 Feb. 1721/2 Sarry Miles Jr. wit. to will of Grace Buckley

8 Feb. 1726/7 Miles Rivers' will names Wm. Miles as Executor; also a witness.

7 Feb. 1728/9 will of Eleana (Wright) Cooper: dau. Frances, wife of John Miles, Island of Medera, merchant.

10 July 1732: Moses Martin names dau. Mary Miles; Executor Wm. Miles.

JEREMIAH MILES: will dated 2 Feb. 1736; elected 4 Dec. 1736 Representative from St. Paul's Parish, Colleton County to serve in Assembly (See Journal of the Coomons House of Assembly Nov.10, 1736-March 5, 1737, p. 33; p. 34 Oath of Qualification administered & he took his seat as member of the House; p. 65 mentioned; p. 66 elected Chairman of the House 13 Dec.1736; p.183, p. 189 mentioned promoting Bill of founding a Chappel of Ease at Beach Hill, St. Paul's Parish 21 Jan.1737;p. 219 "Jeremiah Miles, Esq....being lately deceased..."7 Feb.1737.) Will proved 16 Feb.1737, mentions wife: ELIZABETH and two dau. under 18 in 1736: SARAH and SUSANNA; mentions Edward Perry as his brother-in-law (Perry married ROSAMOND MILES 11 Dec.1723); mentions Thomas Miles, Jr. as "cousin" (actually his nephew).

JOHN MILES married 10 Feb. 1734 Elizabeth Ladson; son. THOMAS and dau. MARGARET bap. 21 June 1741 St. Paul's Parish (p.21 SCH&GM Vol.XIV) (See p. 111 Vol.XIII 1912 for marriage date)
