FORWARD

(Editor's Personal Note)

The Mohlers, as a family, have a few individual characteristics. They are very religious and a high percentage are connected with the ministry, mostly in the Church of the Brethren. Many of the Mohler women engage actively in missionary and church work, married ministers, or sons of ministers. Besides the predominance of ministers the Mohlers are often farmers and teachers. They are a hard working family, generally reluctant regarding publicity, frugal with their money but excellent providers for their families. The Mohlers are generally abstainers from liquor which stems from their religious beliefs. They are a rather clanish family as can be seen by their inclination toward settling in groups in Pennsylvania, Ohio and Missouri. They tend to stick together geographically and often are ready and willing to acturally be their brother's keeper.

After I married into the Mohler family I became curious as to the nationality and background of the Mohler clan and soon became fascinated by the information which I began to find. While tracing the Mohler history I also ran across parts of my own family tree in the same localities as the Mohlers.

This history has been largely contributed by the people contained in these pages. There are several in particular: Mr. Paul Mohler (F4X), Mrs. C. M. Johnson (F22) Rev. John M. Stover (F63), and Mr. Clyde Moher who is not within this history (a descendant of Ludwig's grandson Henry) but who has encouraged greatly the writing of this history. Clyde is from Lancaster County, Pennsylvania and he showed us many of the historic places to do with the original Mohlers. I feel I should also thank my husband, who was patient with neglected household duties, was ever understanding and carefully read these pages and offered many helpful suggestions and additions.

THE NUMBERING SYSTEM is my own and is explained thus: the letter designates the generation - A for the first generation settling in this country, B for the second etc. The first number represents the place of the individual's father in his family, thus, if Henry were the first born in his family, all of Henry's children would have number 1 as their first number. The second number represents the individual's order of birth within his family.

INTRODUCTION

In the early 1700's, William Penn extended an invitation to the peoples of Europe who were being persecuted and exiled. In response to this invitation "Quakers came from England, Scotland, Ireland and Wales; Palatines came from the Rhine section; and Anabaptists, or Mennonites arrived from Germany and Switzerland; the Church of the Brethren, or Dunkards, so called from their belief in triple baptism, came from Germany in 1721; the Roman Catholics from England came here in 1732; the Moravians, or Czech followers of John Huss, came from Moravia and Bohemia via Georgia in 1740 and the so-called Dutch, who were Germans, not Hollanders."¹

"These ancestors of ours were more than mere immigrants in the everyday sense of the word. They were more than refugees from a beloved and bespoiled homeland. They were pioneers in that they came not to a ready-made republic of opportunity but to a virgin land inhabited by savages. They blazed the trail that helped to transform that land into the American character... Together they worked and won, together they fought America's battles and led in public service, industry, science, education, invention and in that art of agriculture which is the very foundation of our national wealth and of human progress."²

"The Mohler family is of German origin, according to "The History of West Virginia", but were residents of Switzerland. The ancestor of the Pennsylvania Mohler family, was Ludwig Mohler who came to America on the ship "Thistle" August 29, 1730, and located at Ephrata Township, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania."³ He was born April 4, 1696 and died January 6, 1754. "His gravestone in the Mohler Cemetery by the Mohler Meetinghouse near Ephrata gives the date .. when back there (I saw) a deed for 290 acres of land which he had bought from Alexander Stedman, Charles Stedman and William Henry Stiegel in 1764 and another

deed which he gave in selling 100 acres in 1765. The Stodmans were Philadelphia bankers, and Stiegel was the "Baron Stiegel" who had a furnace at Manheim and whose products are highly prized antiques today."¹

"It must have been while Ludwig Mohler was still living that one of his sons got 1200 acres of land along Cocalico Creek near Ephrata, for in 1764 there was built a great stone house on that land, still in the family which I visited in 1921. Within a stone's throw of it, was another house of the same size and design built in 1794 and occupied by John Mohler. I took measurements and pictures of this later house. The main house was 44 feet square outside, with a stem running back from the rear middle 31 feet further. (The stem which is referred to is now believed to have been an earlier structure - possibly the original house where the family lived before the rest was built. In both houses this "stem" was the kitchen and was older looking. It is easy to see it had been a separate structure at one time. -ED) The walls are about 16 inches thick. Ceilings are high, two stories, attic and basement. In the basement of each house is a strong spring running along the wall in a channel. There is a big washroom, storage space, and further in, a room with low rounded ceiling with very thick walls to keep things cool in the summer and warm in the winter, I suppose.

"The mortar used in both houses and barns was made with mud packed in the ground for a year. Now the mortar is as hard as the rock, so the walls cannot be torn down without great effort. I saw similar masonry at the Heidelberg Castle in Germany, where an old powder tower had been exploded in some war. A piece was cracked out, but there was no crumbling.

"The Mohler Meetinghouse nearby is a large structure, (It was built on a part of Ludwig's farm. - ED) the third to be built on a great stone basement."¹ In the basement of the church were some old pews which were hinged in the back and could be made into tables at the time of the Love Feast.

All the Mohlers were active in the Church of the Brethren, in Lancaster County, and are still considered in the group of "plain people" of the Pennsylvania Dutch district. They are popularly called Dunkards or Dunkers because of their practice of trine immersion in a flowing stream in the name of the Father, the son, and the Holy Ghost. The Church of the Brethren was founded in 1708 in the town of Schwarzenau on the banks of the river Eder in Westphalia. Many of the early Brethren had been members of the Reformed Church and the older Protestant church persecuted the new sect to the extent many of the Brethren fled to Krefeld on the lower Rhine. From there they sought religious freedom in Penn's new colony and twenty families, consisting of one hundred and twenty people set sail for America, arriving in Philadelphia in 1719; they settled in Germantown and founded their church. (This was the first of many immigrations to this land, Ludwig Mohler arriving in 1730. -ED) They have always been known for their vigorous hymn singing but do not generally have the musical accompaniment of an instrument. They have a Love Feast twice a year which consists of the rite of foot washing followed by Communion, and this followed by a handshake symbolizing "the right hand of fellowship" and by "the holy kiss of charity" on the cheek. (Individual churches have various differences in the ritual, however. -ED) Generally their ministry, as in the case of the Mennonites and Amish, was unpaid and given no formal education. ¹

We visited the Mohler Church of the Brethren, near Ephrata, Pennsylvania in 1956 and some of the older members still sat separated, the men on one side and the women on the other. There was no piano or organ but the congregation sang so well it wasn't missed at all. The older men had beards with their upper lips shaved, wore coats without lapels and wore no ties which could not be seen anyway under the beards. All the women wore the Brethren coverings on their heads. It was a very warm and friendly group and before we were gone we had had three invitations to dinner, and no one had ever seen us before.

CHAPTER I

LUDWIG MOHLER, SON HENRY MOHLER AND

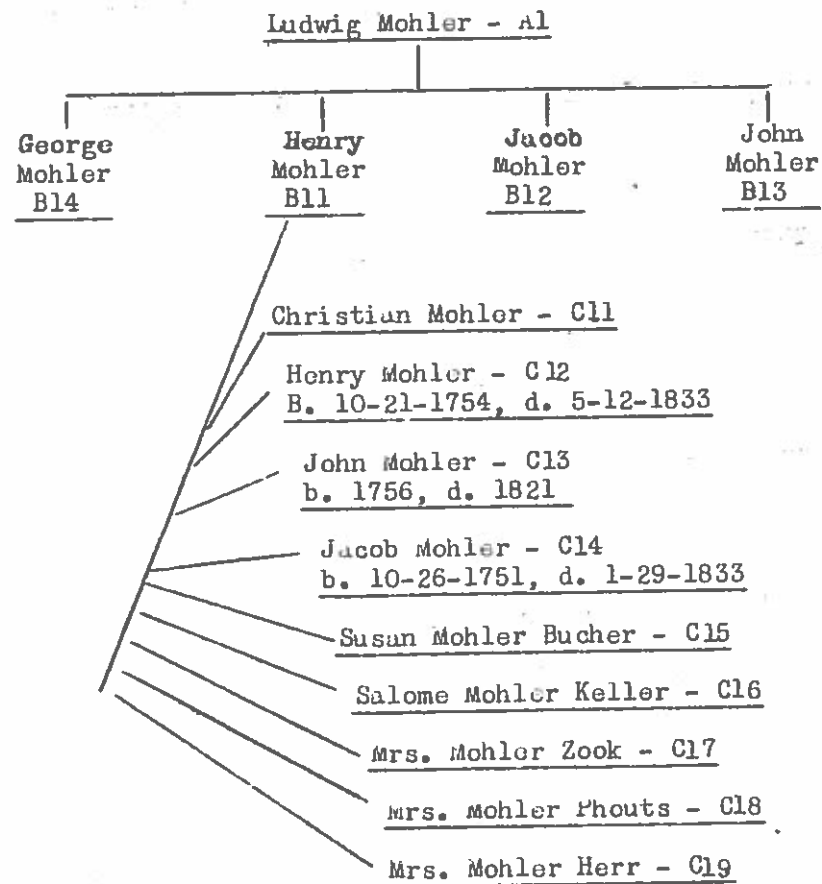
GRANDSON JACOB MOHLER

There has been a difference of opinion between some of the family's geneologists as to who Ludwig's sons were. Some say they were Jacob, Henry and George; some say they were Henry, Jacob and John; some say there was a Ludwig Jr., too. The passenger list on the ship *Thistle*, however, has Ludwig Mohler only since it was customary to only list heads of families. Perhaps George, Jacob and Henry came over with Ludwig and John and Ludwig Jr., were born in this country. At any rate, all geneologists agree that Henry was definitely one son and he is the only one with which we are concerned in this history.

Henry Mohler (B11) was born April 20, 1728 in Europe and died January 20, 1774 and is buried in the Mohler Cemetery near Ephrata, Pennsylvania. There is recorded a Land Patent or Deed from William Penn in 1735 in Henry's name. In 1745 there is a second Land Patent or Deed recorded in his name. We find that many settlers did not take out land in their own names but in their son's name, which would explain his owning land at the age of seven years. According to church records Henry was baptized in 1739. We find that the Elder wrote "and wife", no doubt from force of habit for he was too young to have been married. (Yet history shows that boys were married at fourteen and girls at twelve.) He became a naturalized citizen in Philadelphia on April 11, 1761. Ludwig, Henry and Jacob are all recorded on that date.

"... analysis of the various members of the Mohler family found on the records of Lancaster County, Pen-

nsylvania, and always in the same locality, proves conclusively that the sons of Ludwig Mohler who were with him when he settled there were: Jacob, Henry and George. The record eliminates the son George between 1751-59. (There has been extensive research and work done on George (B14) and his descendants by C. C. Mohler of Hagerstown, Maryland and he has printed a complete book of those descendants.) It shows further that all of Henry's sons and all of Jacob's sons and his grandson John Jr., served in the Revolution in the 3rd Battalion, Lancaster County, Active Militia." 1



Some of the family geneologist list these children of Henry's in reverse order. This grouping here is not their absolute order or birth, as there is a difference of opinion.

William Mohler (E11) was born 10-3-1852 and died 9-29-1851.

Mary Mohler Croft (E12) was born 5-5-1825, and died 2-20-1908. She married George Croft who was born 11-22-1823 and died 3-31-1906. They had three children:

Sarah Croft Stover (F21) married John Stover who was born in 1844 and died 9-18-1896. John Stover and his brother Emanuel Stover both married into the family. Emanuel married Jannah M. Mohler Stover (E66). Sarah and John had four children:

Ora Stover Snyder (G11) born 9-25-1875, died 4-18-1940. She was married to Jessie Snyder who is still living. They had one daughter:

Margaret Stover Snyder Baker (H11) who married J. L. Baker and they had two children:

Eldon Baker (I11) born 9-2-1935 and married Mary J. Burge.

Janet Baker (I12) born 11-18-1941.

Mary Stover Maurer (G12) married John Maurer. They had no children.

George Stover (G13) born 10-18-1879 died in infancy.

John W. Stover (G14) born 8-9-1882 died 1942. No children.

Mollie Croft Luckenbaugh (F22) married George Luckenbaugh and had no children.

Elizabeth Croft (F23) born 2-4-1860, died 4-6-1918. Never married.

(There were also three other daughters (F) who died in infancy.)

Ephraim Mohler (E13) was born 10-10-1826 and died 10-14-1904 and is buried in Leeton, Missouri. He was married to Anna Nill who came from Germany in 1832 in company with her father George Nill and family and Aunt. It is told in the "Mohler Genealogy and Historical Record" by Sarah Ella Mohler Garber (FX8) the crossing was quite an experience and that they passed through a severe storm when most of the company were very seasick. At times they were becalmed for a number of days, when the sails hung slack and the vessel lay motionless. The voyage took 85 days at sea and landed at Baltimore. 12

Ephraim and Anna had fourteen children:

Mary Mohler Wenrich (F31).

George W. Mohler (F32) who was born 12-16-1849 and died 8-5-27. He did not follow his father into the "Old Order". George was a farmer, teacher and Brethren Church Preacher m12-25-1887 Mary Elizabeth Deeter was born 11-10-1856 and d11-25-1939. She was the daughter of Samuel Reed Deeter and Susannah FRESHOUR. Susannah's Great-Grandmother was Rachael Hoover who was the sister to former President Herbert Hoover's Great Great-Grandfather, John Hoover. We have corresponded with the family of the former president and found them most cooperative in giving us the needed information. The Hoover family has traced their tree back to Europe and the 10th Century. George and Mary Elizabeth had ten children:

Oliver W. Mohler (G21) was born 1-15-1879 and died 10-1953. He was born at Covington, Ohio and is buried there. married Minna Davis from Darke County, on 8-1-1902. He was Township Clerk for 20 years and earned his living as a farmer. They had one child:

Carlton Davis Mohler (H11) died in his youth, about 16 years old, of a congenital condition.

Emma Mohler Patty (G22) was born 7-14-1880. She married Boyd J. Patty 4-8-1904 and is a farmer in Miami County, Ohio. They had one daughter:

Mary Ellen Patty Keller (H21) who was born about 1921 and is married to Harry Keller. They had three children:

Ronald Keller (I11) born 2-25-1943.

Karen Keller (I12) born 8-31-1947.

Nancy Keller (I13) born 8-20-1948.

Ella Mohler (G23) was born 7-14-1880 and was the twin sister of Emma (G22) and died in 1898 of typhoid fever at the age of 20. She is buried at Sugar Grove Cemetery. She had been engaged to her twin sister's husband's brother.

Charles Sumner Mohler (G24) was born 3-27-1884 and died 12-24-1946. He was married to Mildred Eisenbargar. He taught advertising at Ohio University, was connected with the American Medical Association in Chicago and was especially responsible for the magazine publications. He attended Miami University, Oxford, Ohio and taught school in his early life. Both he and his wife were killed on 13

Christmas Eve in an automobile accident while in route to their daughter's home. They had two daughters:

Maxine Mohler Mihalik (H41) born about 1913 and married to Andrew S. Mihalik and living in Detroit.

Elizabeth Jean Mohler (H42) who was born about 1919. She is a dietician in California.

Samuel Deeter Mohler (G25) was born 9-14-1887 and is married to Jennie Celeste Whitaker. They were married in 1916 and Jennie was born 8-30-1891 and was the daughter Charles Lincoln Whitaker and Celeste Morrison. He graduated from Miami University and was a member of the Delta Upsilon Fraternity. He has always been an active layman in the Methodist Church as well as the Masonic Lodge and Kiwanis. He is presently owner of the Whitaker-Mohler Printing Co. of Hamilton, Ohio and is responsible for the binding and covers of this book. They presently reside at 545 Ridgeland Avenue in Hamilton. They had three children:

Charles Whitaker Mohler (H51) born 1-1-1918. He married Dorothy Jane Beckett (8-3-1940) who was born 1-17-1918. Both are graduates of Miami University. He is a member of the Delta Upsilon Fraternity, Masons and the Methodist Church. He is in business with his father at the Whitaker-Mohler Printing Co. of Hamilton, Ohio. (He and his wife grew up next door to each other.) They presently reside at 1055 Elizabeth Drive in Hamilton. Their two children are:

He is a member of the Beta Theta Pi fraternity, and employed as Assistant Manager of the Beaver Falls office of Mellon National Bank & Trust Co. of Pittsburgh. They presently reside at R. Henry Mohler (E14) born 3-18-1829, died 2-25-1892, was the first child of Rudolph's second wife, Elizabeth Miller. Henry married Hanna Deeter, daughter of Abraham Deeter and Grand-daughter of pioneer David Deeter. Anna was a cousin to Mary Elizabeth Deeter, wife of George W. Mohler, (F32). Henry was born in Jumberland County, Pennsylvania and was a farmer plus operating a saw mill on the Stillwater River. He had a large homestead which exemplified his industry, enterprise and mill. He was 13 years old when his family moved to Ohio. He and his wife were always active in the church of the German Baptist. They had 8 children, 6 sons and 2 daughters. 1 son and 1 daughter died when quite small.¹ Henry withdrew from the church in favor of the "Old Order" in the early 1880's.

Abraham Mohler (F41) married Emma Cassel. They both died young and left no children.

Joseph D. Mohler (F42) born 11-14-1859 in Miami Co. Ohio. Married Mary Warner 11-20-1879 who was born 6-24-1861, died 5-6-1948. Joseph died 6-20-1921. He became an "Old Order" minister - one source said he belonged to the "Old German Baptist Church" which may be another name for "Old Order" - owned the farm of his father, after his father's death. 3 children:
