

GEORGE NORTON

St. Michael's Parish, Barbados; will dated 3 May 1665:

Therein he leaves various amounts of sugar to Mrs. Thomas Morris, a friend, to John Clark, a poor fatherless child whom he has befriended, to Robert Hales and Anne Stuart, his servants, to his brother, JOHN NORTON of Millingsworth, Warwickshire, Eng., to his sister, Mrs. Mary Bailey, wife of Richard Bailey of Coleman Street, London, and to his sister, Mrs. Hannah Walker, wife of Edward Walker of Barbados.

He also left ~~money~~ to his son JOHN NORTON his interest in the Cape Fear adventure where John is presently "my agent".

His estate to be divided into three parts, two of which were to go to son, JOHN NORTON, when he reached the age of 21. The other third part was to be divided between ~~his~~ twin daughters Mary (the eldest) and Hannah.

Executors are: John Norton (his son), Richard Hawkins, Anthony Lane, Edward Pelham, Armiger Warren, etc.

Proved 12 May 1665.

George Norton was father of John Norton of Charleston, S. C. who was father of Jonathon Norton of Beaufort, S. C., Vestryman of St. Helena's Church in 1754.
