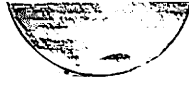

Eleazer Truheart (2) Jane Reynolds (dow. of his 1st cousin Benjamin + wife Mary) Zacharias and Philip Reynolds. Richard's brother William - wife unknown - had: Benjamin md. Mary - had Jane and Wm. ; Wm. Jr. who md. Eleazar Ireland, wd. of Jos. Scott. Would you like a copy later of what I have - from Joe Hart? I don't know that Mrs. Day you mentioned - had been in correspondence with a Reynolds cousin in Fla. -

Dottie Smith - descended from the Reynolds who went to Alabama.
