Thomas Wiggins - member of Dort, Pleasant ¹⁷⁹¹ Bapt. Ch. (formerly ¹⁷⁵⁶ Cashaway) branch of Welsh Neck at Mars Bluff, Pee Dee
Alexander McKenzie & Elizabeth McK.
S.C. Baptists (1670-1805) Leah Townsend

Thos. Cater of Ashley River Congregation (May 20, 1752) trustee of fund of 250 £ trust for Baptists. (Church became extinct during Rev. War.)

Thos. Dixon, ~~pinning~~ group observed 24 June 1745 as day of prayer + fasting + signed covenant reaffirming Calvinistic principles - built new Church at South end of Church Street.

Orangeburg District:

Zeagler and Zeagler's Mill on

northwest of Orangeburg) on the
Columbia Road.

Colleton District (surveyed 1820)

FOLK on Savannah Creek between the
