Sir Thomas Massingberd, Knt of St. John of Jerusalem under Henry VIII was son of Richard Massingberd and Maud (dau. of Thomas Kyme) and grandson of Robert Massingberd and Agnes (dau. of Robert Halliday of Burgh) married Joan (dau. of John Braytoft of Braytoft). died. 25 May 1552.

His son: Augustine m. Margaret (dau. of Robert Elrington of Hoxton, Middlesex). died 1549

His son: Thomas of Braytoft Hall, last M. P. for Calais 1553 m. Alice (dau. of Richard Bevercoats of Newark) died 1584

His son: Thomas m. Frances (dau. of Sir George Fitzwilliams of ^{Co. Lincoln} Mapletorpe) died. 11 Sept. 1620 _{knights 3 Jan 1607}

His son: Thomas of Braytoft Hall and Gunby, Lincs, Barrister-at-Law, m. Frances (dau. of Robert Halton of Clee, Sergeant-at-Law, by Joan, dau. of John Drayner (or Drayner) of Hoxton) died 5 Nov. 1636 (aged 74)

His son: Sir Drayner Massingberd, the Parliamentary Commander, purchased Lordship of Ormsby in Lincs. & 11 Dec 1615 married Anne (dau. _{d. 13 Dec. 1692} + co-heir of Henry Mildmay of the Graces, Essex, by his 1st wife, ^{in Little Badow,} _{Cecilia} dau. of one of co-heiresses of John Barker, Esq. of Hammond. co. Salop) m. on ⁶ Dec. 1678; was Sheriff of Lincoln 1644, knighted by Charles II 17 Feb. 1661; died 1688. _{"may"}
