Subject: Lots of the Bache family

Hi

As promised one large document. I hope the format is fairly easy to understand

The pdf document has William Bache's will from 1637 it's on the last page.

Each page starts with the man in the relationship, then his wife, followed by their children. Even when I know more about the children's spouses I've only put a name in, otherwise we'd be getting into documents twice the size of this one!

Direct ancestry is in bold text. Square brackets are references to the English birth marriage and death indices.

The second page is the family of the parents of the man on the page before, and so on (except I've cut generations of Ensells!) until a stop is reached, then it goes back to the parents of the female of the last page, then back down the female families following each in turn. (Probably easier to look at than describe)

There are Thomas Baches in every generation, the one Elizabeth Rhodes (nee Bache) generation I only have an approximate year of birth for, the one in the generation above was married, so the bachelor could be her brother. 1782 was the year her uncle died. What you qoute from his will matches what I know of his nephews and nieces (I don't have a Hannah, but there is a 5 year gap between children at one point!)

I will do a bit more study, and then get back to you. This is a family that hasn't had much study from me yet, as it's a long way from home.
