Bridgnorth Stoneway Chapel Register (non-Conformist.)

In 1709 the congregation built its first meeting house on Stoneway Stepson land bought from Thomas Wellstone and Anne, his wife. It was a double gabled structure, built like Matthew Henry's chapel at Chester, the roof being supported by two large pillars rising from the middle of the chapel. It stood for 170 yrs.
