This is a big and expensive order and I wish I felt it could be done. However, it's been my experience that most of the work is done by one of two people on committees.

The Rev. Pierre is nicely done in the Old Brick Church, but it could be nice if those in 2,3,4,5, and perhaps 6 were done there.

My specifications would include these requirements:

Unless we know a person is buried in a locale, the marker should state "In Memory of" and also something to tie the person in with who they were and why they were important. It would be better for us to do one or two and do it well than to have only the name and the dates. We care about future generations and the marker should include some phase of that person's importance, i.e. Jeanne Braye Robert, wife of Pasteur Pierre Robert, Judith deB. Robert, wife of Pierre Robert, Jr., etc.

I don't wish to throw cold water on this project but I feel strongly we should have certain standards that will be as lasting as can be hoped for for many years.

Thank you for letting me hear from you. (And as you well know I'm behind on the Edisto Island Markers-- my plate is overflowing with worthy projects many of which are in need of completing.
