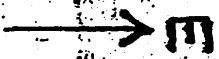

GEORGE MORRIS, son of G.S. & R.B. Morris, Nov. 3, 1850 - Sept. 2, 1851, age 9 mos., 29 days,

JAMES HAMPTON WALLER, son of J.G. & A.J. Waller, Jan. 13, 1847 - July 10, 1848

JONAS PLATT, Infant son of Jonas & Isabella Ann Platt, died Dec. 4, 1850, aged 11 days
