Dear Cousin Robert, A P:S to my earlier to-day

Enclosed is the top part of the MEMORIAL #184-1733 Chicken, Geo. You can tell that I have traced parts, and I'm sorry about the poor quality. The H-S of S.C. has copies of this, along with Law Suite Rev. P. Robert & wife vs Brenner, to teach her, dau of Brenner to Cook & Sew.

I only have notes on Paul Robert, s of Jean, living on the 7 Acres, Home Place, 2 May 1733 Memorial Kinlock. However, it is enough for me, & I hope who ever else is interested.

Jean Robert & 1st Wife (now thought to be Marie Remy) Children:

Elias Robert, just added Roberts & became Robert Roberts, 1757 Colleton Milita. Some of his children, or G-children/sons were in West Florida quite Early: Children are thought to be: William (Purrysburg-1735 Plat), David Port Royal-Tailor, Jamie (Rather than Jacques/James), Samuel (who may belong to Jean) next to Jacques Robert Cedar Creek-Geo. Dist, Robert Jr., Maybe Ruth M(1723 Nich. Newlin) OOPS 1726 Thos Weaver, Mary M 1723 Nich. Newlin Charleston. & Col Owen, bc 1720, who I thought possibly was Jean's son, b just prior to A-I.

Since the youngest son has ment something in out Family, I really tried on Elias; but contrary to Tammy Lawton, there are NO RECORDS in S. C. on Elias ROBERT. He's in Merchant Business with Sealy quite early, as Robert R.

Remember, the son of Jacques R. Elias, the Surveyor had the "s" added to his name, or was that his g-son, Thomas County, Ga. 1850? It sounds as if Lawton has picked up on the ole folks saying in S. C., "that if they have the 's' on their name, they do NOT belong to us".

I think:----shortly after Rev. P. passed on, (I say 1716 plus), the sons decided to: P-II stay ROBERT, Jean spell ROBARTS, Elias, ROBERTS. BUT- it did not work out that-a-way. P-III became Roberts, Jonah's Thos "s". Only a very few remained ROBERT. Only John Robarts, s of A-I, used the Rhobart spelling. A-II signed Robert 1 Rev. War Indent, next Roberts.

Dear Robert:

It is real good of you to answer, and give me the benefit of your knowledge & Experience, so fast too.

How & Why did Jean/John Robert come to have Rev. P. Robert 200A on the Santee, if he was not a SON? This was sold to Geo. Chicken 1732, when Jean/John Robert left Santee, but retained 7 Acres----The Home Place & Buring Grounds---which later went to LeGrand. Would a nephew be given-sold-willed such? If that 7 Acres could talk, then we would know, for sure, over here, without all the costly Foreign Work.

All I have is the Chicken MEMORIAL Vol #; p 184, with other Land: 500A from Peter Robert (Jr)& 200A from Judith Robert. For me, (as Mrs Burns said, "You will find enough data that points to a fact, that you will, NOT need the Record to say it is so."); this is enough Proof for the Society.

Paul Robert, who d young c 1740-50, lived on this land 1733 Memorials 3:407. who no one has suggested was g-s of Rev. P. I feel sure a Tailor, who had about 3 sons: Thomas, John & William, Fr. Santee Tailor, father of Stephen Robert, & ~~John~~ William Robert s, & Thomas Roberts. (Thos Roberts, s of Jean, was adm/exor John's Estate)

You may rember our past letters, when I 1st found Jean Robert, wife & une fille arriving in Virginia 1700/01? The une fille is his Sis Mary, or Marie M-1 Wingate/Winjet & M-2 Hay/Hays/Hayes, I would bet my last nickle. She born c 1682, since fille means a grown un-m gal.

Jean Robert M Marie Remi (Remy) Nov. 1693. If Jean b 1677 (P-II plus 2 years), Nov. 1693 he would have been 16 plus, according to my figures? That is when Rev. P. M Jeanne Braye 1674. A Abraham Remy was (about) NATURALIZED Virginia, with John Robert & Claude Phillip de Richebourg, Abraham Michaux, a John Thomas, Parmentier, Roux (Rue), and a few others that came on down to S. C. by 1709, or so. The 500Acres Land Grant, --to me--means Rev. P. Robert transported 10 of his family, to S. C., at 50A per person. Jean, who had c 4 childreb bb 1700-1709, - 6 Elias, who was Naturalized London 1708, or 09 early, came with wife, maybe 1-2 children, most probably an English, or Welsh lady, ----AND dau Mary/Marie, maybe with 1-2 children. I --think the other 50A, next day was for P-III, who he remembered, with all of the Excitement of his whole Family being together again.

In a way I hesitate to write you about this,---but: Your Thomas Lawton has rejected a cuzan of mine for the Huguenot Society of S. C. Quote: "PASTEUR PIERRE ROBERT HAD ONLY ONE SON, PIERRE, JR, ACCORDING TO ALL RECORDS FOUND THUS FAR". "UNFORTUNSTELY, THE INTERESTING ARTICLE BY N.E.R. OF MONROE, LA. DOES NOT PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION TO PROVE THAT JEAN ROBERT WAS A SON OF REV. P. ROBERT, ETC."

Annie E. Miller receives no consideration at all!

You know, during our correspondence, a few years back, in the early 80's, I felt something was wrong with Thos. He wanted every scrap of data I had on P-II, & descendents, on Rev. P., & such, but did NOT want to do anything about: JEAN & ELIAS, & MARY/MARIE, the dau no one has Published anything about.

I think all concerned, 4-5 agree that Rev. P. & Jeanne Braye Robert had at least 3 sons: P: Jean/John; Elias, probably who was Naturalized London 1708/09, & was In S. C. by June 1709, when Rev. P received the 500 A Land Warrant/Grant, for 10 of his FAMILY.

Now, Rev/Dr. Wm. F. Roberts, Jr., my preaching cuzan can not join, as I had asked for an Application, knowing that Jean-Abraham I, II, III had been accepted by the Society. An't that a shame?.

Thos would not even find where Rev. P. was 2/1674-2/1682, which I think we have:Marson-old Champgane. Jean Robert M 1693 Marie Remi (Remy) Virginia at Fr, Huguenot Church, Basel, Suisse. Maybe this is ours. However, I do not have the money to continue to try to get copies of the PROOF. Cuzan Bill was going over there this summer, as his wife still works for Delta Air Lines, but now I won't even ask him to search.

OH well,----I hope all is well with you & yours, and thank you very much for your Prayer re Mother. If you have any thoughts re the above, 1st ppg., will appreciate a short note.
