- ROBERT, Elizabeth, dau Jacques Robert & Jeanne Nicolas, b 20 March, 1682, baptised 28 March 1682, Vol VII, p 2.
- ROBERT, Marguerit, of Montpellier, France, married Antoine Vedel, of Montpellier, France, a Merchant in Dublin, 11 July 1704, in The French Church of St. Patrick, Dublin, Ireland. The Pub. of Hug. Soc. London: Vol II, p 109.
- ROBERT, Marguerite, & her Husband Antoine Vedel, their dau Marguerite Vedel buried 7 September 1707, by Mr. Rev. Veridet. Infant, age about 5 months. Register of France Church, St. Patrick, at Dublin. Pub. of Hug Soc. London: VII, p 195
