Eastward on Mr Isaac Legrand Land to the Westward on James Mallock  
Egg Land and to the Southward on said Mallock Legrand Land this  
Land lies in Craven County and was granted at that Yearly and Part  
of One Shilling per Acre and one Penny the 26<sup>th</sup> day  
of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & thirty three.

of the Parish of St James Parish in Beason County in the  
Province of South Carolina Pursuant to an act of  
assembly in that case lately made & provided that

Indenture of Release and Lease bearing date respectively the  
Twenty eighth & Twenty Ninth days of February in the year of our Lord  
One Thousand seven hundred & thirty and made between John Gendron Esq  
& Judith Robert both of Beason County in the Province of South Carolina the  
Executor & Executrix of the last will & Testament of Peter Robert Seneschal  
of the County & Province aforesaid lately Decd of the one part and the Memorialist  
by the name of George Chicken of Berkeley County in the Province aforesaid  
of the other party whereby the said John Gendron and Judith Robert  
conveyed unto the Memorialist Two Tracts and assigns first two tracts of land  
that is to say, One tract land containing two hundred acres more or less situate  
lying and being in the Parish of St James Parish in the County of Beason Province of South  
Carolina & bounding to the North on Santa River to the East on land formerly  
of Paul Bruner lately of the said Peter Robert Seneschal to the South on land now  
of John Robert to the West on land formerly of Mr James Boyd as by the  
Platt off seth, and One other tract of land containing four hundred acres  
more or less which lying and being in the Parish of St James Parish in  
the County and Province aforesaid & bounding to the South on  
Santa River to the East in land of the said Peter Robert to the West on  
land of Mr John Gailard Due to the North on a line as met & set out

 On Indenture bearing date the twenty ninth day of April  
 in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred & Thirty two  
 John Robert of Craven County in the Province of South Carolina Com-  
 pany was the Mayor and by the name of George Chicken of the County  
 appeared the here and assigns One Hundred and Ninety three acres  
 of land, being part of a tract of two hundred acres of land which One  
 Hundred & Ninety three acres of land is Putting & Bound to the North  
 ward on Mr James Boyts land and Peter Roberts Egg Land to the  
 Eastward on Mr Isaac Legrands land to the Westward on James Kinloch  
 Egg Land, and to the Southward on said Kinloch the Legrand land the  
 land lies in Craven County and was granted at that Yearly and Rent  
 of One Shilling for a hundred acre of land on the 26<sup>th</sup> day  
 of May in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred & Thirty three.
