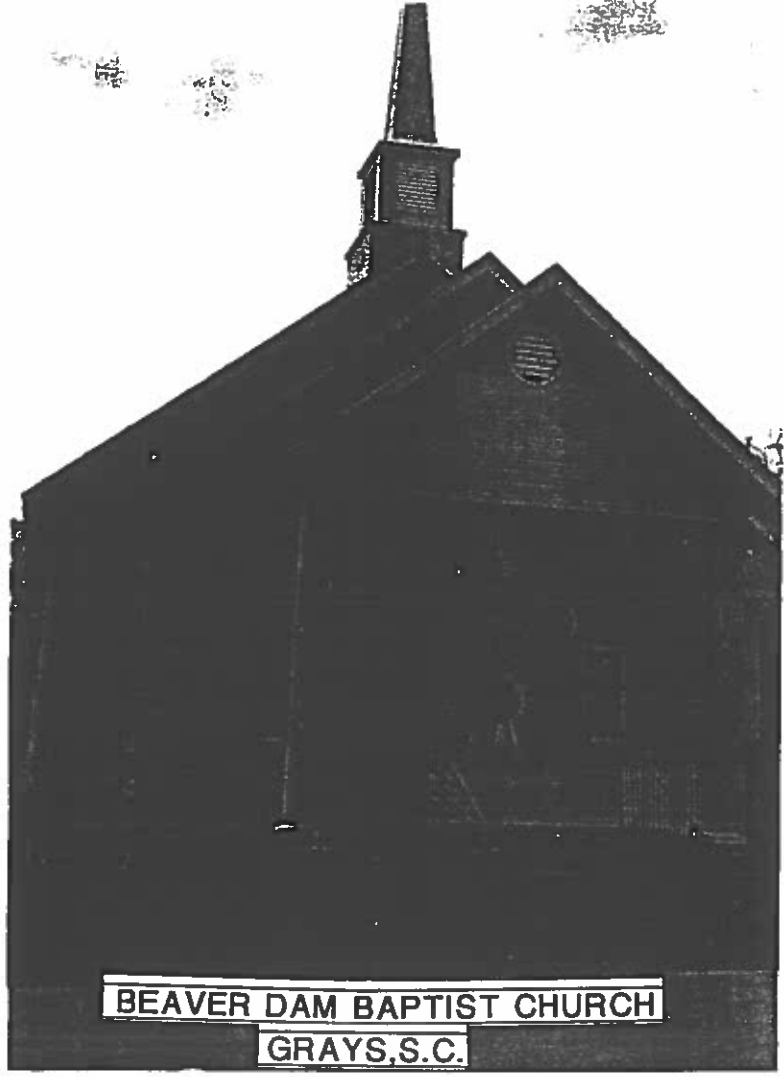

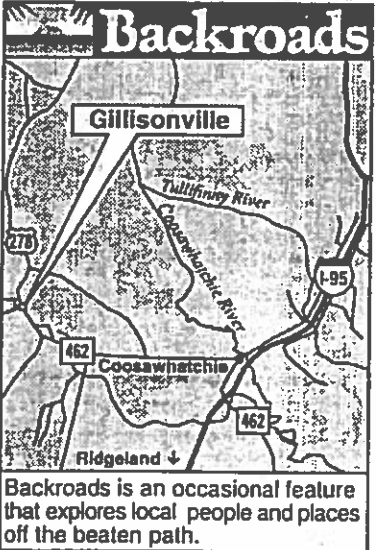

Gillisonville's glory days

Former district hub holds onto snippets of the past

GILLISONVILLE — Peterman's General Store, established in 1845, remains open for business on U.S. 278, facing a vacant block with mounds of weed-covered ruins.

A historical marker about 10 miles north of Ridgeland reminds a traveler that Gillisonville once served as the bustling government seat for the Beaufort District from 1840 to 1868.

Jasper County now owns the empty square block where the courthouse and its gallows once stood. Today, its tranquility is interrupted only by the highway traffic passing by.

General William T. Sherman's army burned Gillisonville on its march through South Carolina in early 1865.

Sherman spared the Baptist

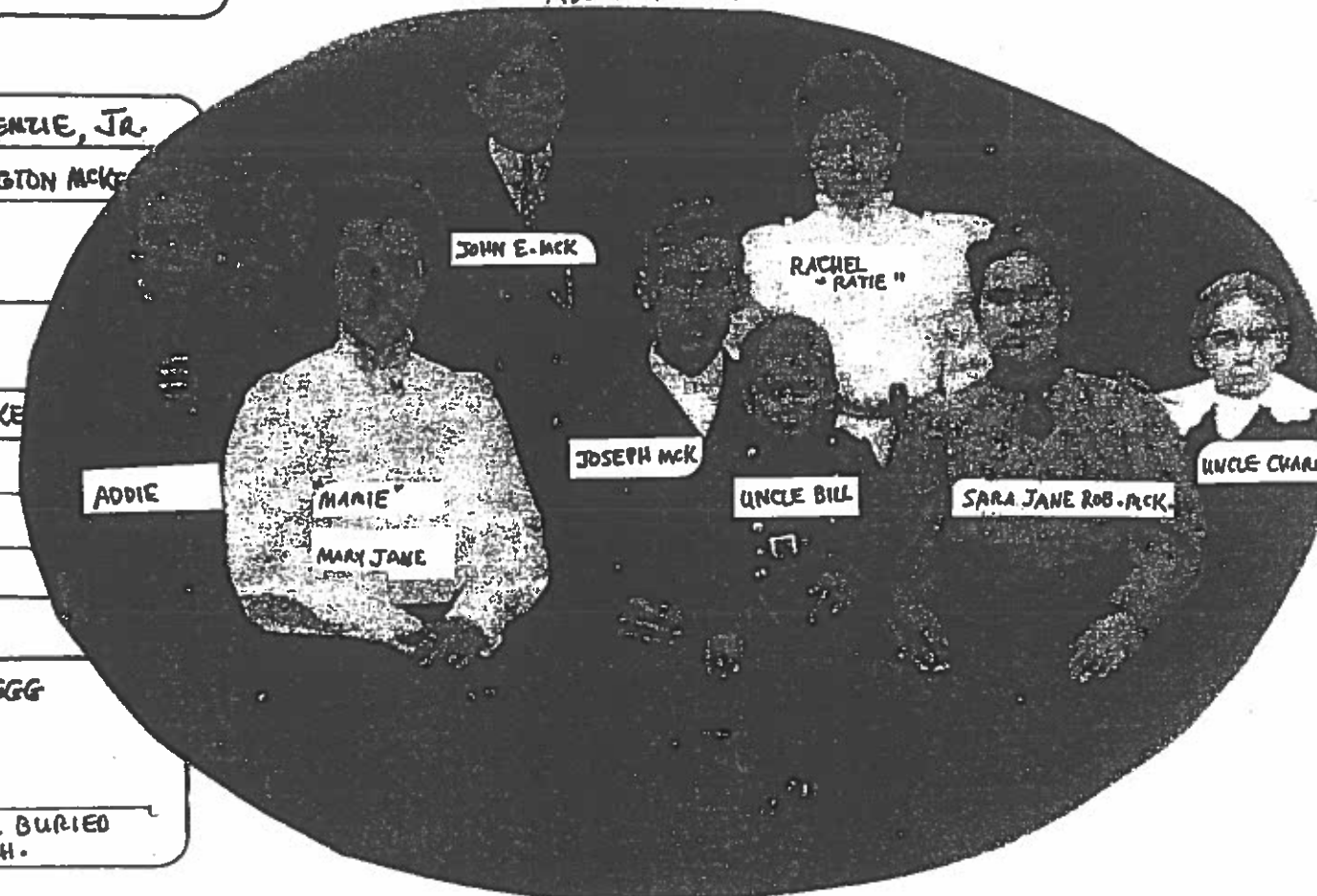

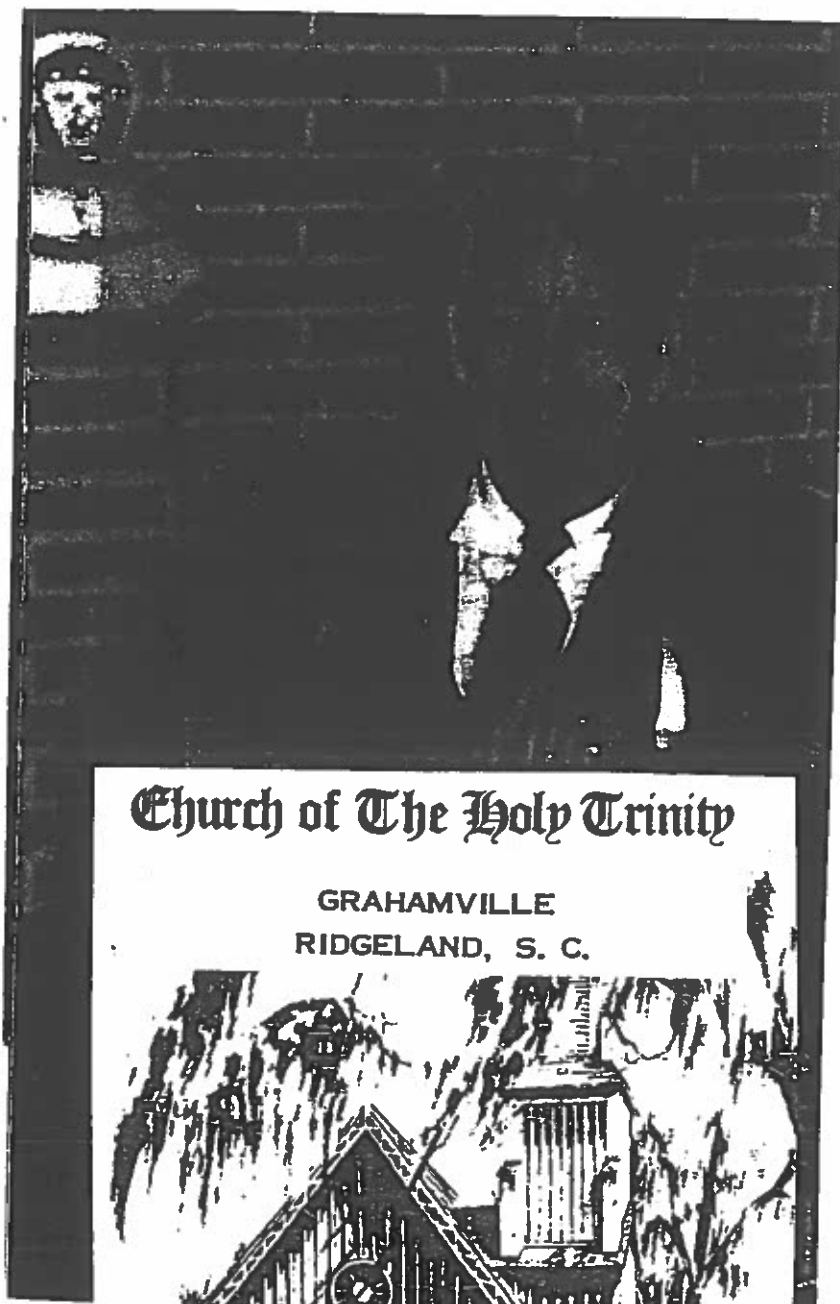

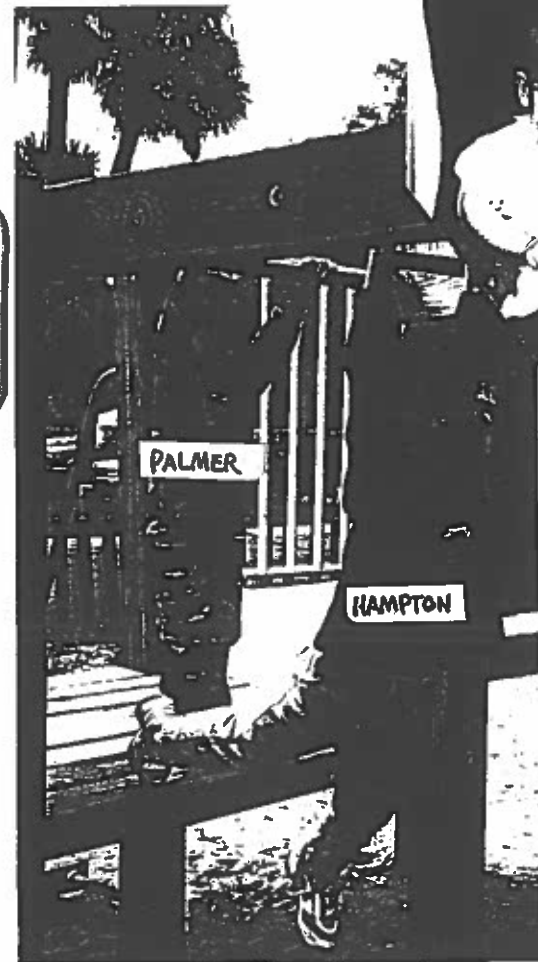
