It was our ancestor William Roper (1495-1577) who married, in 1521, Margaret More, dau. of Sir Thomas More (1478-1535), Lord Chancellor of England. In his note of Sept. 9, 1980, Prof. N. Jistic, Archivio Segreto Vaticano, offered no criticism when he returned my text ending his letter with "best wishes for yourself and for the successful completion of your work."
