DEEDS REVEAL CEMETERIES

Editor's Note- Many times the only remaining evidence of a family cemetery is contained in recorded deeds. Below are two examples revealed in Darlington deeds. The first deed is also unusual in that the dower release is given by the mother of Malcum M^cCullum.

State of South Carolina) Know all men by these presents that I Malcum M^cCallum of the state and
Darlington District) district of Sumpter, for and in Consideration of Eighteen Hundred Dollars, to
me in hand paid by Peter Dubose, Sen^r., of the district of Darlington and State
afors^d. have Granted, bargained sold and Released...Six hundred and Fifty Seven Acres, the Same being in
Six different Survays, part Situated in Sumpter District and part in Darlington District, Agreeable, to a
Resurvay Made and plated of the Said Six hundred and fifty Seven Acres, of Land, by John Cain and
Certified by him the Said Cain to be Kenneth M^cCallums Lands, Bearing date the 13th day of January 1798,
the above Mentioned is the Land sold by Malcum M^cCallum to Peter Dubose Sen^r., his heirs and assigns
forever, Together with all and singular...and Every Part, and parcle thereof, appurtaining unto the said Six
Tracts or parcle of Land in the Whole 657 Acres...In Witness, hereunto I have set my hand and Seal, this

thirty first day of August In the Year of Our Lord Eighteen Hundred and Eleven and in the 35 and 36th Year of the Independence of North America

MIXON CEMETERY 1844

The State of South Carolina } To all whom these presents shall come I W^m Wingate of Darlington District
and State aforesaid send Greetings. Whereas by virtue of an order issued out
of the Court of Ordinary held for the District of Darlington in _____ the following to wit: On due
examination it is ordered and decreed that the Lands described in the summary in partition in this case be
sold by the Sheriff of Darlington District on the first monday in March next on a credit of two annual
installments the first to be paid on the first of January 1845 and the balance to be paid on the first January
1846 purchaser giving bond...I have in obedience to the said order to one directed offered at public vendue
on the fourth day of March A.D. One Thousand Eight hundred and forty four all that tract of Land situated
in the District of Darlington containing Four Hundred and Sixty Seven acres more or less being a part of the
Land of which Jehu Mixon died seized bounded on the Northwest and west by W^m R. Taylor's Land South
and west by Lynches Creek East by M^{rs} Sanders Lands and South East by Jerry Belks land (one half acre of
land is however reserved for the family burying Ground now in use) and whereas W^m Crosswell became the
purchaser of the said Land for the sum of Eight hundred dollars that being the highest sum bidden therefore
Now Know ye that I W^m Wingate Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said order...I have granted bargained and
sold...unto the said W^m Crosswell his heirs and assigns forever the said tract...which the said Jehu Mixon of
right had of in and to the same To have and to hold...

In Witness whereof I the said W^m Wingate have hereunto set my hand and Seal the fourth day of
March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and forty four.
