DEEDS REVEAL CEMETERIES

Editor's Note- Many times the only remaining evidence of a family cemetery is contained in recorded deeds. Below are two examples revealed in Darlington deeds. The first deed is also unusual in that the dower release is given by the mother of Malcum McCullum.

One Thousand Eight hundred and forty four all that tract of Land situated in the District of Darlington containing Four Hundred and Sixty Seven acres more or less being a part of the Land of which Jehu Mixon died seized bounded on the Northwest and west by Wm R. Taylor's Land South and west by Lynches Creek East by Mrs Sanders Lands and South East by Jerry Belks land (one half acre of land is however reserved for the family burying Ground now in use) and whereas Wm Crosswell became the purchaser of the said Land for the sum of Eight hundred dollars that being the highest sum bidden therefore Now Know ye that I Wm Wingate Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of the said order...
