SHELL FAMILY

Dear Mr. Peeples:

I cannot give you the parentage of James Shell, born NC ca 1814. I'm sorry. The best I can do is to narrow your search, and offer some suggestions.

Yes, Gaspar and Caspar are the same name. As you now doubt recall, various letters are interchangeable: P and V; V and B; C and G; T and D, etc. Also -- one requirement in early days for governmental office, was the ability to speak and write English. Seldom did these often Scotch-Irish office-holders also speak or write German. And German immigrants spoke German dialects, not a standard language. (I speak of the 1700s.) The result was the most astonishing variations in spelling of written records. And unless a pastor of high education wrote down the church records, himself, in educated German, even church records in the U. S. require inspiration to decipher. (Once again -- the 1700s and before.)

I am presently of the opinion that probably your James Shell is a grandson of Caspar Shell. However, there was at least one other Shell family in the vicinity of Lincoln/Burke County, and perhaps two. And here I should note that the county line between Linc. and Burke changed back and forth a number of times. I often have run into deeds which speak of land "formerly in Burke Co. but now in Lincoln" or vice versa. The same families lived on both sides of the county line.

I am enclosing an abstract of my records on the descendents of Joh. Caspar Shell, written some time ago, and which I have corrected in several places. I should re-type it, but am now pressed for time. So you will have to take it as is.

You will note that Joh. Caspar and family remained in Pa. for some years, removed to Hagerstown, Md. for some years where the oldest son, Johannes, married and finally removed into Linc. Co. NC, where he died. The oldest son, Johannes, preceded his father into N. C.

Will of Caspar Shell: "In the Name of God, Amen. I am at present in a sickly condition and do not now how long God Almighty will spair my Life I have resolved to make my last Will how matters are to be Transacted after my Death and have it all Down....I Bequeath and make over unto Charles Frederick Shell fifty Dollars extronery and after that for to have an equal share with the Brothers and Sisters. Secnndly I Bequeath unto Marey Conrad one Bed, Bedstead and one Heffer and calf and a Spinning Wheel and then for to fall an equal Share with my children (and Known Share upon her mother's Side). Thirdly, all my Stock and property shall be sold at Publick Sale, Excluding what I have willed. Where unto to Set my hand and Seal, This 2d day of June An Domie, 1804.

I Recommend Henry Shell and Christian Hawn as my Executors of my Estate.

God Almighty Give his Blessing unto Who I have willed and give me an Easy Rest and recover Joy and love in his Glory. Amen Amen. Written in Lincoln County."

As was customary with German-speaking persons, the will was obviously dictated. Many were literate in German, but not English.

As you can see, Caspar did not name all his children in the will. Charles Frederick was the youngest, and had stayed at home to look after his parents, delaying his own marriage until after they were gone. No doubt the extra money willed to him was in some small recompense for this service. The rest of the children have been picked up from church records, county histories, other wills, deeds (Caspar deeded to his son, Caspar, Jr., for example) censuses, etc.

There are gaps in the records, as well. Burke Co. records (except for those of the Court of Ps and Qs), were destroyed during the Civil War. Other gaps exist also. Some of the records on Henry are speculative. It is believed that he married more than once, but the wives names are unknown to me. The Linc. Co. Court of Ps and Qs, reveals that at January Court, 1807, Henry Shell instigated suit against Joseph Stevenson. Court found for the plaintiff -- no payments nor set-off. Defendant owed 32.10 to the plaintiff, plus damages of 2.2.3 and 6d costs. Judgement was for 34.2.3. Normally this would indicate the settling of an estate -- an inheritance from a father-in-law in this case. However, it's slim proof in this instance, and also there's no proof that the wife was necessarily a Stevenson. Joseph Stevenson could easily have been administrator for someone of a totally different name.

You will note that several of John's children removed into Tennessee as did John, son of Henry. I believe you should make an earnest effort to locate your James Shell on the 1850 in Tennessee. I don't dispute that he was born in N. Car., but am of the opinion that he probably grew up in Tenn. If so, it may be his father left a will in whatever county of that state.

\* I can state definitely that your James is not a descendent of either Michael or Caspar, Jr. who went into Missouri prior to their father's death. My husband descends from Caspar, Jr. who x Fanny Mull.

Ralph T. Shell of Chicago, Ill., made an intensive effort to locate and record all Shell records in central N. C. and produce a coherent account of the family. This, many years ago; I believe he is now deceased. Among his records is the following: "...a large family of Shells into present Catawba County (cut off from Linc. mdl)....Based on the records, Joseph Shell, a school-master, was the first of the name to settle in the South Fork are. A (Tryon) Lincoln county deed (1-300) dated 9/22/1770, shows he bought 200 acres on Beavercreek, a branch of Mountain Creek, from Michael Hoyle, weaver, both of the county. This tract of land had originally been granted to Jacob Cook in 1767. Not enough is known about Joseph Shell to give his history and descendents, or to say whether he ever taught school in the school house that stood nearby on the Henry Hallman grant. In 1794, he witnessed a deed for a Frederick Shell of Sullivan Co., Tenn., who is believed to have been his son and who had married Catharine Crisman in 1790, the year in which he was commissioned a Lieutenant in the Tenn. militia. A younger Joseph Shell turned up in eastern Tenn. from where this Frederick was operating a freight wagon all the way across to McMinn Co. TENN, as early as 1809. In 1803, Joseph Shell bought two tracts of land near that of Peter Mull, John Shell and John Fisher, on the waters of Henry River, from Martin Tommis (Thomas; 21-204). He sold this land in 1805 to Benjamin Shell. He and his wife were shown in the 1820 Burke census, as old and living by themselves..." (This suggests that their family had scattered, mdl)

If you get into legal records, you will find the surname spelled: Shell, Schell, Sholl, and Shull.

As for Lorena Eaker and her book "The Shoe Cobbler's Kin", it is an account of the Eaker family and introduces the Shell family only as they intermarried -- in Missouri. You would not find it particularly helpful, I think.

He is a former president of the Arkansas Gen. Society and has done considerable research of his own, having published a couple of books that I know of. He is distantly related to me as well as to my husband. While I do not think he can do actual research for others (he is still in practice), he is knowledgeable about resources in Arkansas and will know of someone who could search records for you. A county history on the family might well give several generations of data. Such should be verified, of course, but could prove invaluable, none-the-less. And an obit could offer information, too.

And when you have identified your James Shell, I'd like very much to know what you have found.

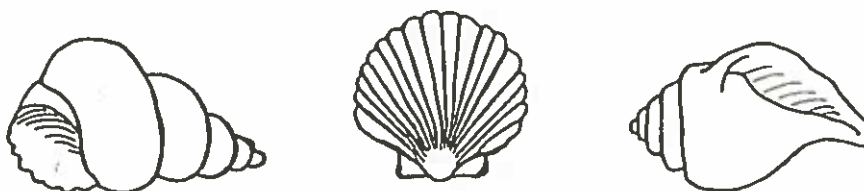
Neglected to mention: The inventory for Caspar Shell was taken in 1805. Also, another account gives the first witness to his will as being Abraham Cook.

Dear Mr. Peeples:

I have reviewed my Shell data but do not find anything new for you. I'm very sorry.

You do not tell me whether Cherokee is a county or village. My maps reveal both in North Carolina. Cherokee County was erected in 1839 from Macon County. Macon was erected 1828 from Haywood County. And Haywood was erected 1808 from Buncombe County.

This means, of course, that minutes of the county courts, deeds, wills and administrations in all the above counties should be searched. Such search should reveal the parentage of James B. Shell. I don't know of any other way to achieve your goal.

Yes -- I think it likely that he is a descendant of Caspar Shell I, but via which son, I do not know. Benjamin, Joseph, or Henry Shell are the best bets.

Lucinda Breckinridge Shell -- her middle name could represent some ancestral intertie, but not necessarily. One of my Lutes girls in Missouri married an Alexander Bruckner Snider. Quite an aristocratic name. But so far as I can tell, there was no relationship with the Bruckners. In fact, I have not found such a family in southern Missouri. So it could be that Breckinridge was just a name the mother liked. The ethnic Germans were not prone to preserve the mother's or grandmother's maiden names. The English, Irish and Scots were the ones who did that.

If I had to bet on it, I would bet on your man as being James Benjamin Shell.

I have reviewed the alphabetized census listings for Tennessee, Georgia, Kentucky, North Carolina and Arkansas, all 1850.

No!

I find your James B. Shell in Philips Co. Arkansas, page 140.

It would well worth reading the 1850 return for this family and see where they reported their birthplaces. And then, there are old newspaper files. If you are certain James B. died in McMinn Co., Tenn., perhaps you could find an obituary.

I note that Athens is the county seat of McMinn County. I also note that Ralph Shell says in a letter dated Sept. 2, 1942, addressed to Walter A. Hahn of Hickory, N. Car. that there are 2 towns in Tennessee named after sons of John Shell. A good map might enable you to identify them. (This would be John, son of Caspar I).

If your James B. was a Methodist, there was a newspaper called "The Christian Advocate" which published obituaries. It has been filmed at the Salt Lake Library and is available at branch libraries of that church. You would have to order in the film. cost \$3.50 or perhaps \$2.50 for 2 weeks. I rather forget right now the cost of renting films.

I'm sorry I don't have more information for you. But if you do nail your James B., I'd like very much to learn what you have discovered.

OBADIAH WHITE

Obadiah White was born in Virginia in or near the year of 1799. He moved to Tennessee about the year of 1823. He married Martha Patsy Mansell that same year 1823. Martha was born in the State of South Carolina. Obadiah was quite a craftsman. He built a grist mill and a large dwelling home somewhere near the location of the Guffey-Shell Cemetery. He and Martha raised a very large family of sons and daughters. When their children reached well into the years of adulthood , some migrated to Illinois while others migrated to Texas. Their daughter Lucinda remained with her parents and later <sup>27 July 1841</sup> married James Shell. Obadiah and Martha sold out to James and Lucinda Shell and moved to Monroe County, Tennessee during the Civil War years. Martha died during the year of 1880, and Obadiah brought her back to McMinn County and buried her, and built a sturdy log cabin over her grave. Obadiah died about 1893, one year after after his great-great granddaughter (Pearl Guffey) was born. Obadiah's descendants buried him alongside his wife under the log cabin he had built with great love and affection. The cabin sheltered the resting place of those pioneers for more than sixty years then succumbed to time and weather in the early 1930's or later.

Martha (Patsy) Mansell was born in S. C. about the year of 1800. She and Obadiah sold out to James and Lucinda White Shell in 1863 and moved to Monroe County, Tennessee . She died sometime between 1870 and 1880 for she didn't make the 1880 census.
