

NOTES FOR YOUNG FAMILY CARDS

LOCATIONS USED ON FAMILY GROUP SHEETS

COUNTIES - The United States Census maps from 1800 to 1880 show Beaufort District or County including what we know today as Hampton, Jasper and Beaufort Counties. Hampton County was formed in 1878 from part of Barnwell and Beaufort Districts. In 1912 Jasper Co. was formed from part of Hampton and Beaufort Cos. In 1919 Allendale Co was formed taking a piece of Hampton Co. just above Gifford. Union and Laurens Counties are in the western part of the state.

INDIVIDUAL NAMES

REV. STEPHEN YOUNG, 2nd – This name is hard to pin down as there are a number of Stephen Young listings in the state, none with the same family, but may or may not be related – see 1870 census sheets. He does not show up on the 1900 or 1920 census in Hampton, Barnwell, Beaufort or Allendale Counties. None of his children show up in the 1920 census as Youngs.

BLOSSOM FIELDS – Trying to find her parents is also hard. The 1870 census shows two in Beaufort County and one in Barnwell County but they are too old. There were two families in Hampton County in 1880 named Fields but they had different wives. It might help if we knew whether Tunno was a real name or a nickname.

RECORDS USED IN SEARCH

On all census sheets the dates shown in parenthesis are dates of birth – within one year. Differences in dates of birth may be due to no written record of birth and use of memory.

United States Census for 1800, 1850, some 1860, 1880 and 1920. Those for 1900, 1910 and 1930 are in the process of being put on line and indexed. Indexing the records makes reading them much easier – you enter the name you are looking for and location and a listing of reports for that name are given to be searched. Otherwise you have to read the census sheets for a given area page by page until hopefully you find the name you are looking for. So it is possible that more information will be found at a later date.

NOTES FOR POLLIN FAMILY CARDS

LOCATIONS USED ON FAMILY GROUP SHEETS

COUNTIES – These are the same as those shown for the Young Family.

INDIVIDUAL NAMES

BECKETT – The 1870 census does not have any listed in Beaufort or Barnwell areas. There are a number of Becketts, black and white, in Georgetown and Charleston Counties. However none show the names of Rueben, Betsy or Julia.

POLLIN – The census reports for 1790, 1800 and 1810 do not have any listings for Pollin in the Beaufort and Barnwell Districts.

At present the 1930 census shows a number of Pollin families in Allendale County, Wilson Twp. beginning on page 20. When this is indexed I will track them all down.
